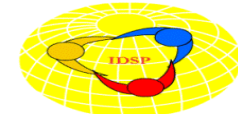
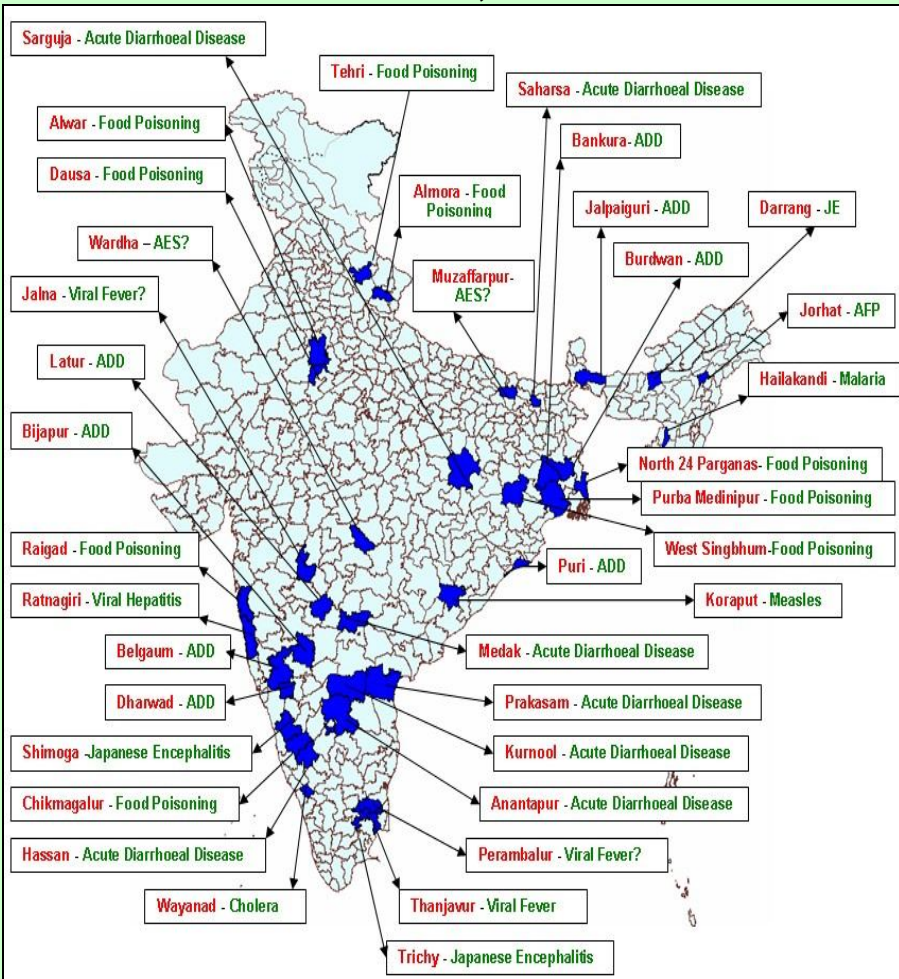




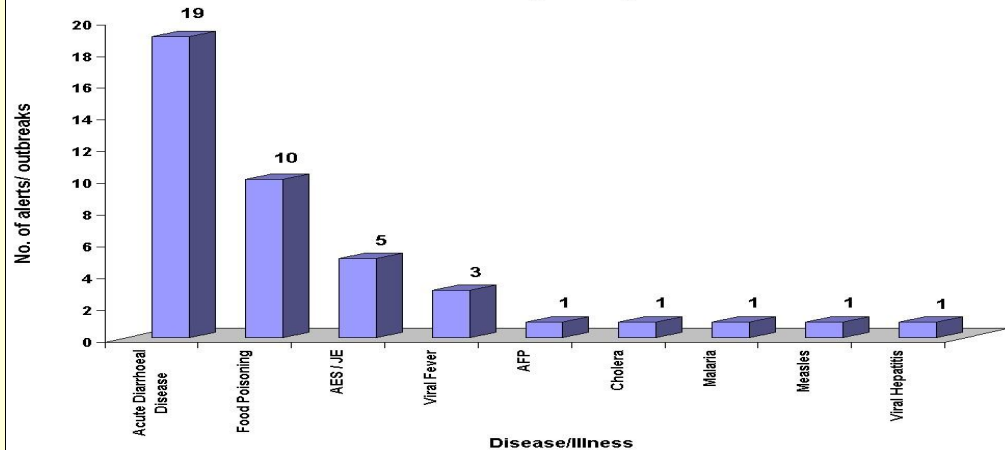

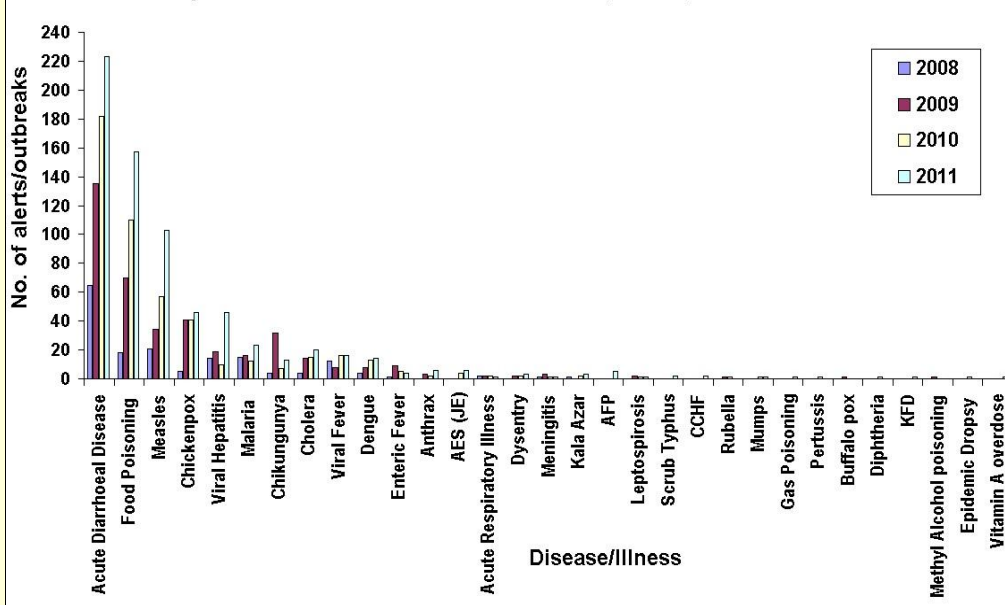
District wise disease alerts/outbreaks reported in the 25th week, 2011

District RRT visited and investigated the affected area. Most of the cases are clustered around the well which is the main source of water in the affected area. 4 out of 5 water samples sent to Rajganj Water testing Lab found contaminated. Active search done for new cases. Disinfection of well done and people advised not to wash clothes or take bath near the well. IEC activities undertaken regarding safe drinking water and sanitation measures.
