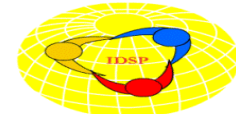
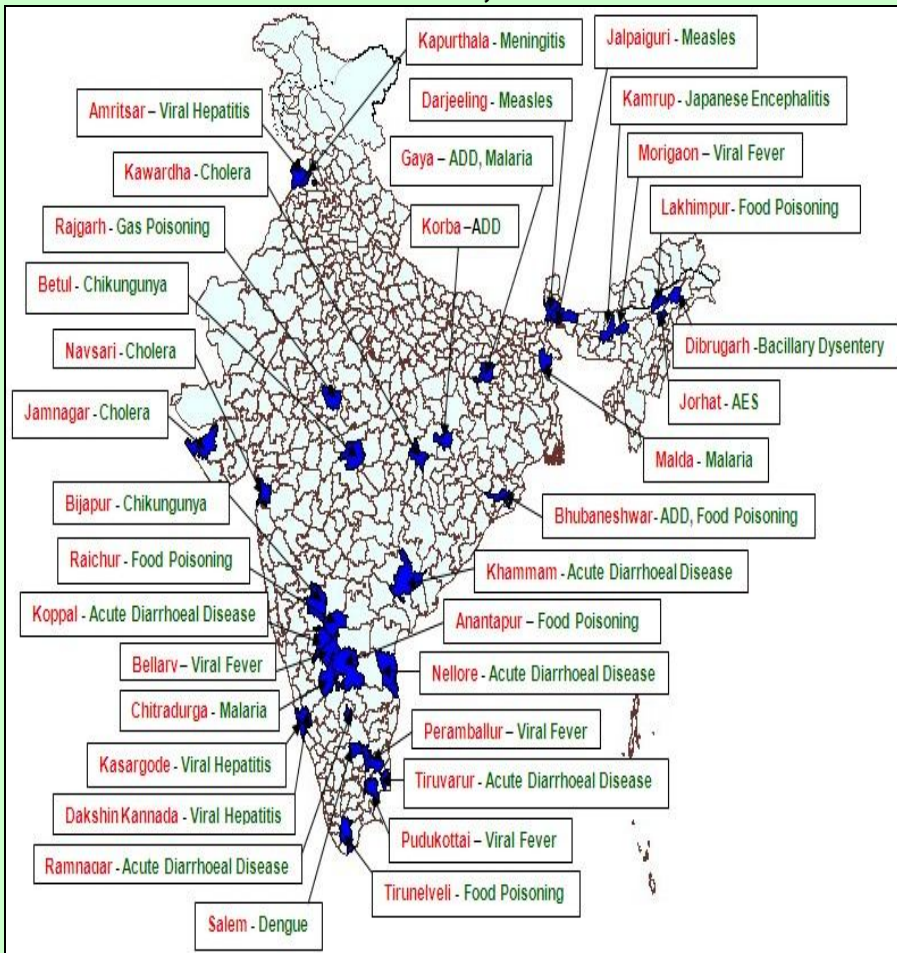




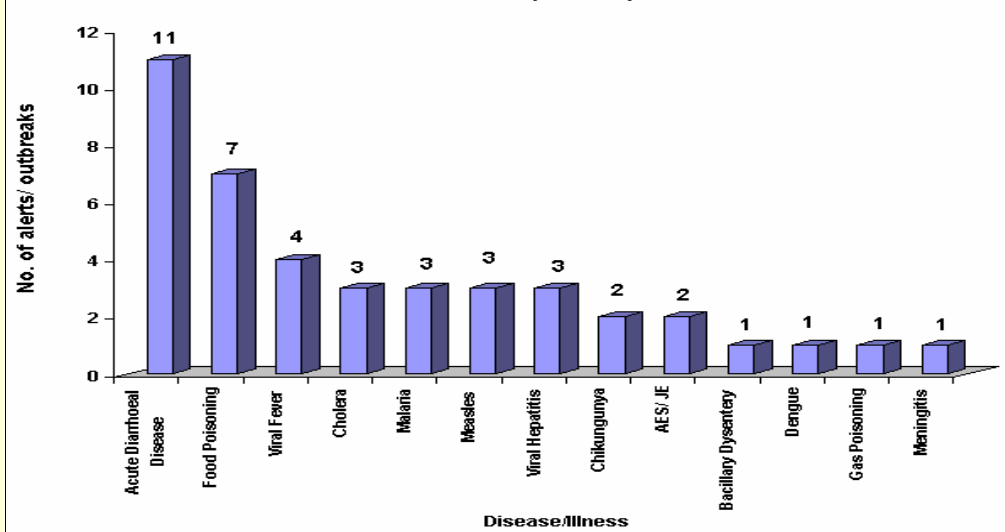

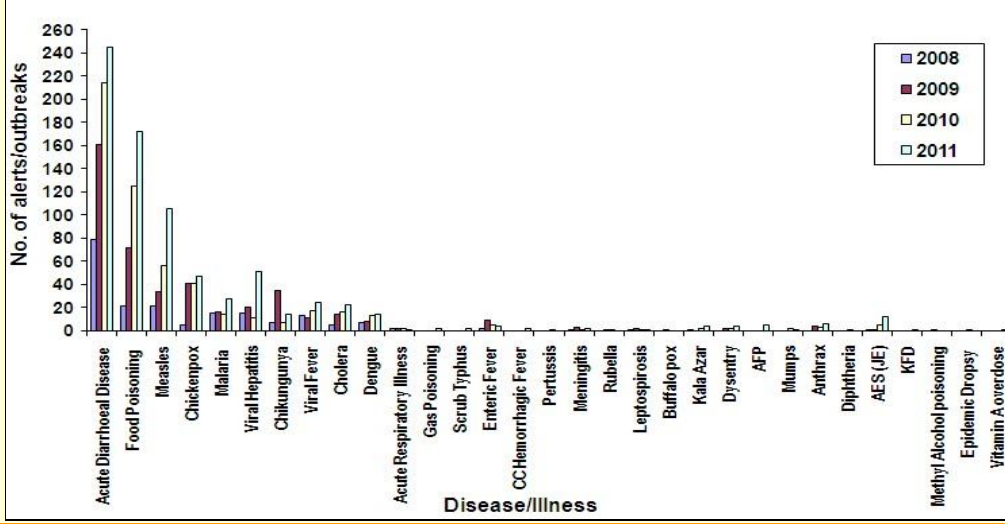
District wise disease alerts/outbreaks reported in the 27th week, 2011

Chlorination of water sources done. House to house survey done to find new cases and ORS packets distributed.
