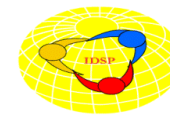
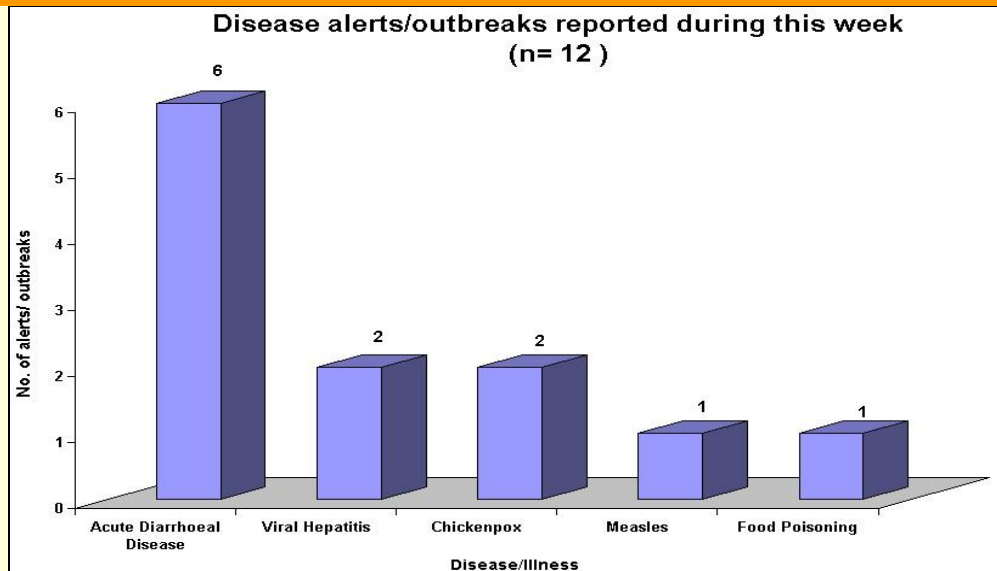
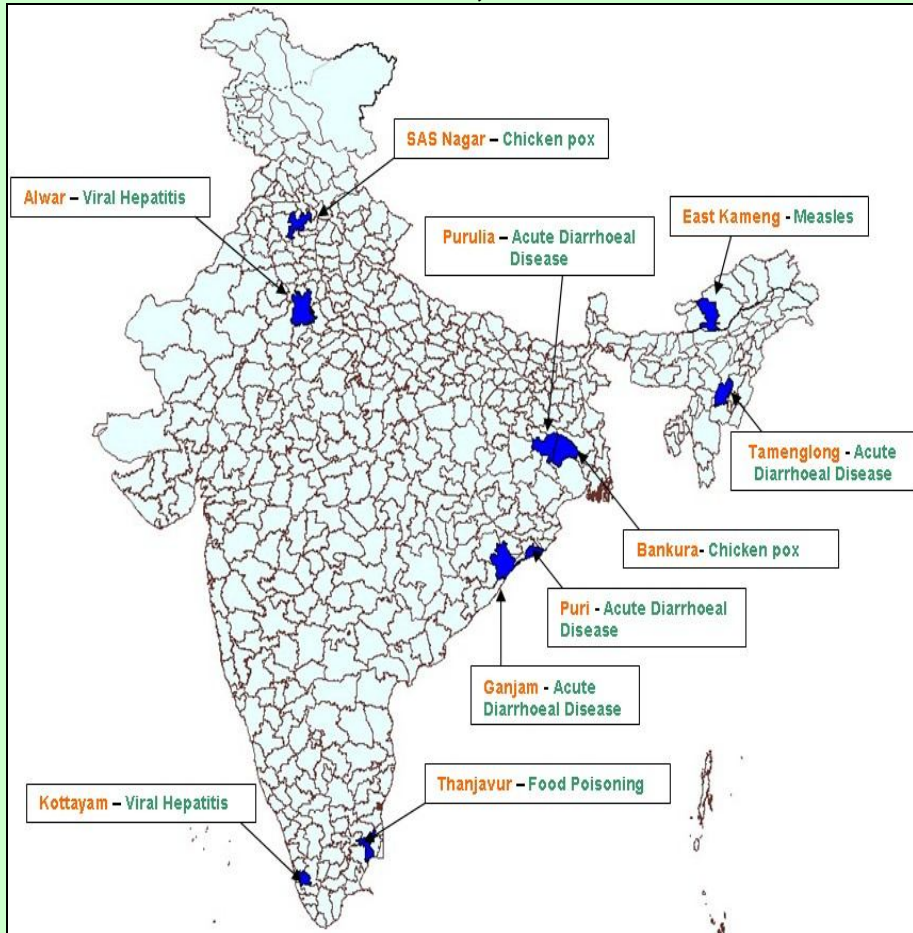




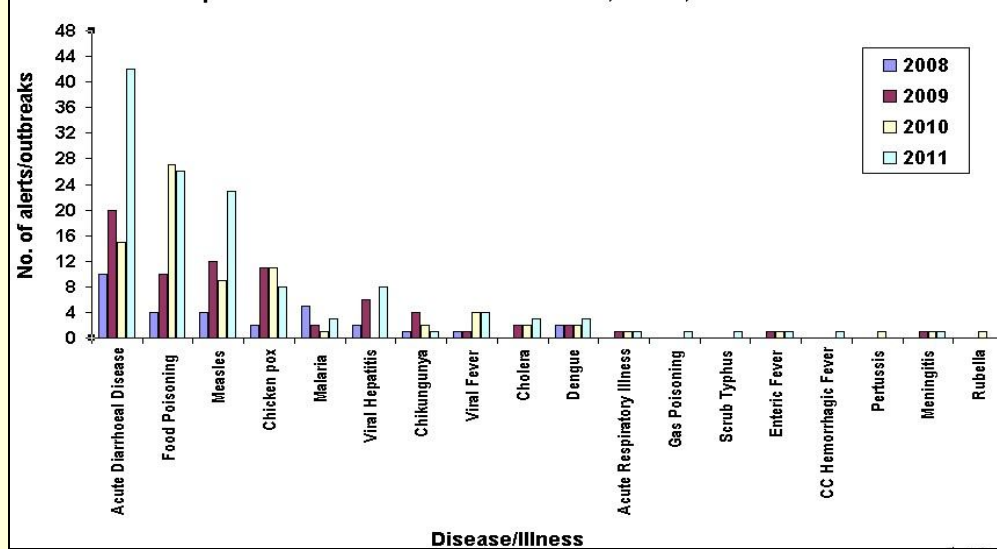

Stool sample collected and sent to MKCG medical college and hospital; lab report awaited. ORS packets distributed among the affected people. Village meeting conducted with health staff. 1 private vehicle arranged and kept in the village for transporting cases to the health centre. Daily active surveillance through door to door visit for early case detection going on. IEC activities undertaken regarding safe drinking water, hygienic practices and sanitation measures.

Water sources chlorinated. ORS packets and halozone tablets distributed among the households.

Chlorine tablets distributed among the households. IEC activities undertaken regarding hand washing and sanitation measures.
