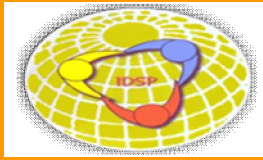


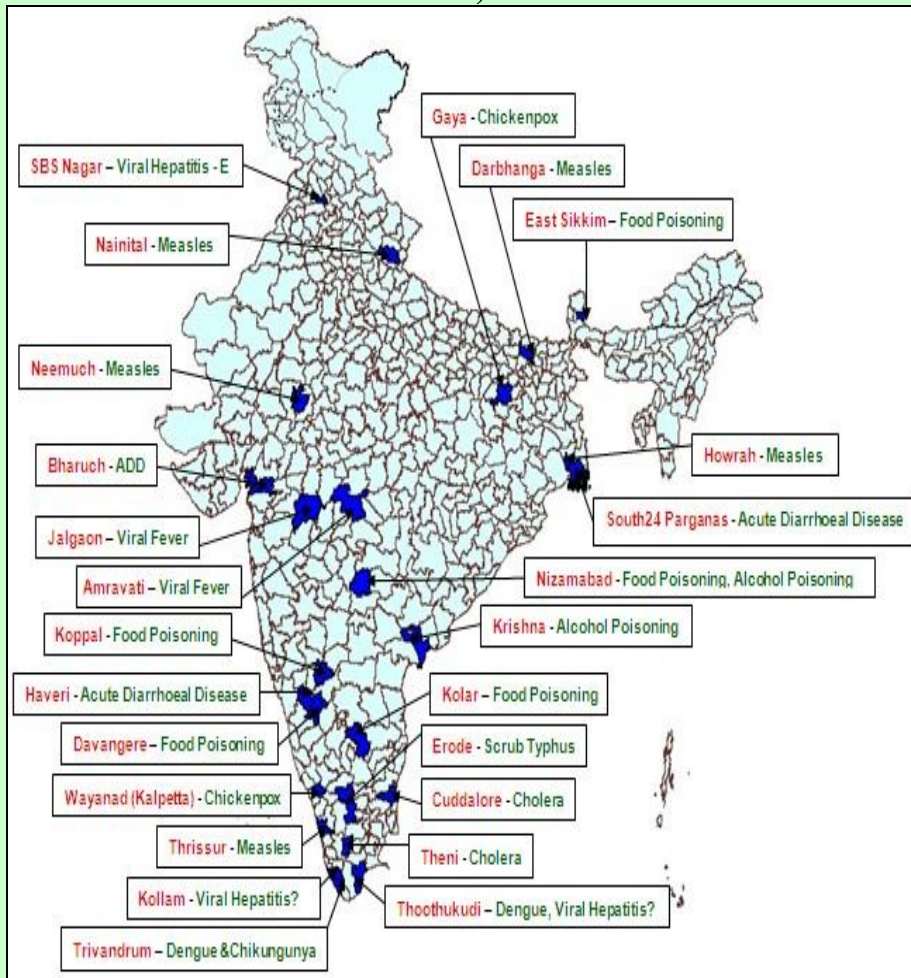

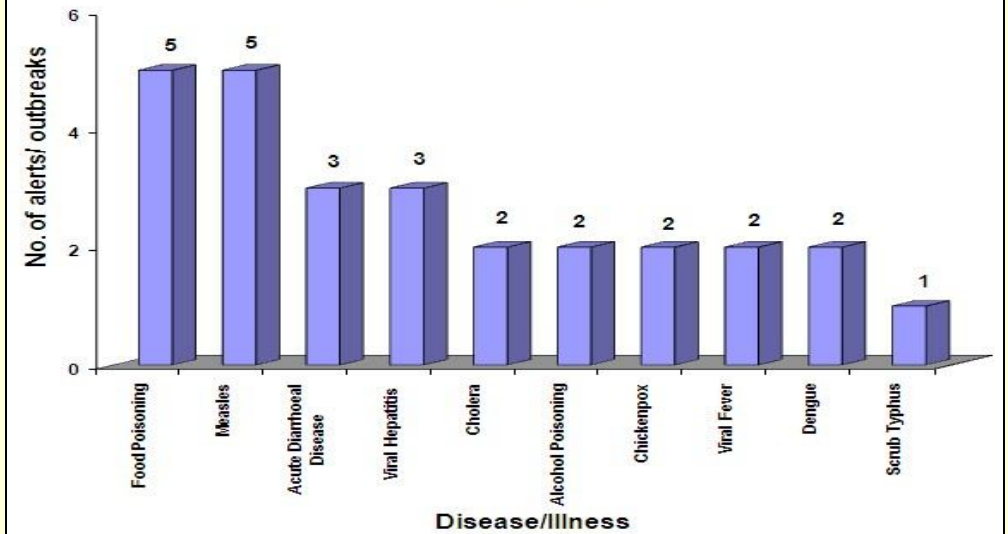

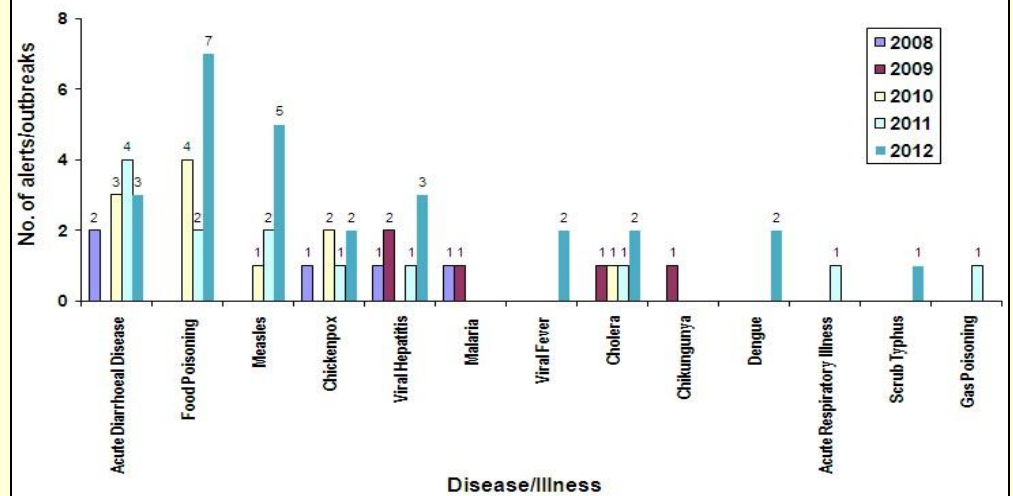
District wise disease alerts/outbreaks reported in the 1st week, 2012
