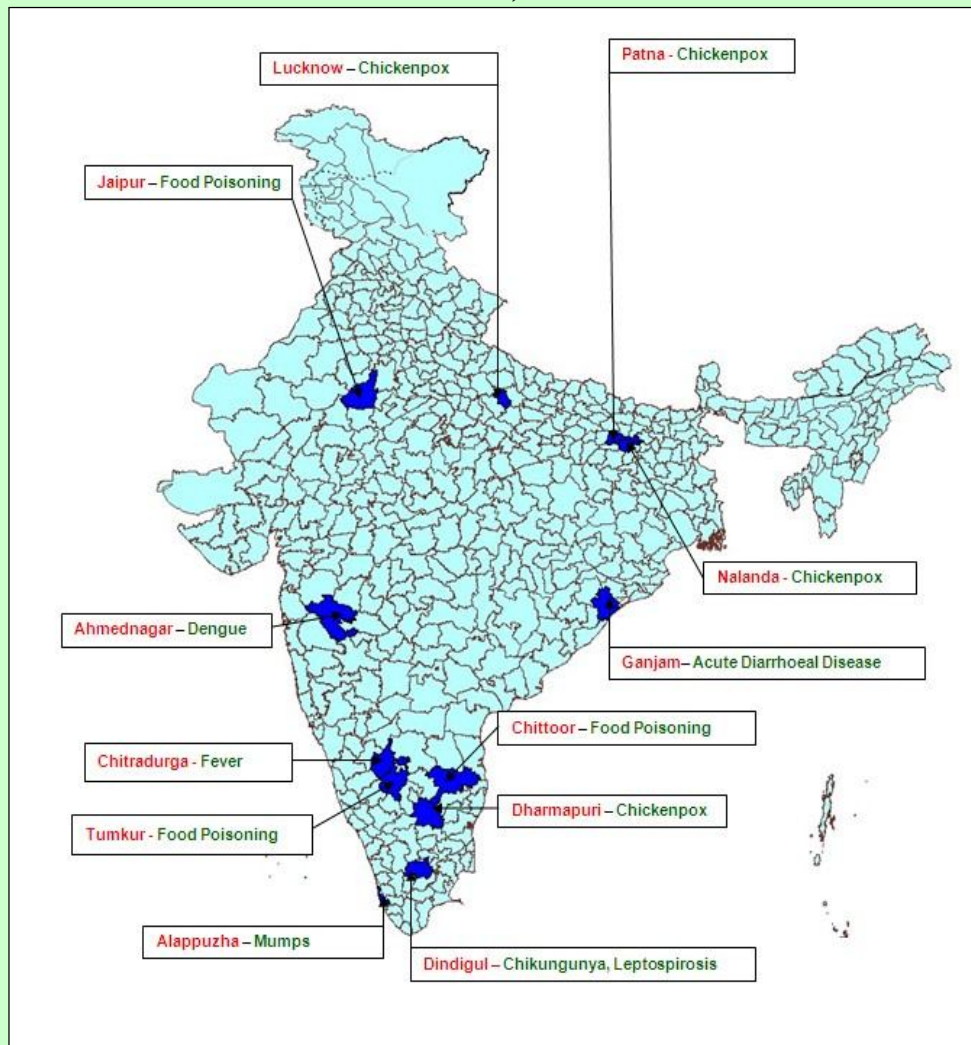




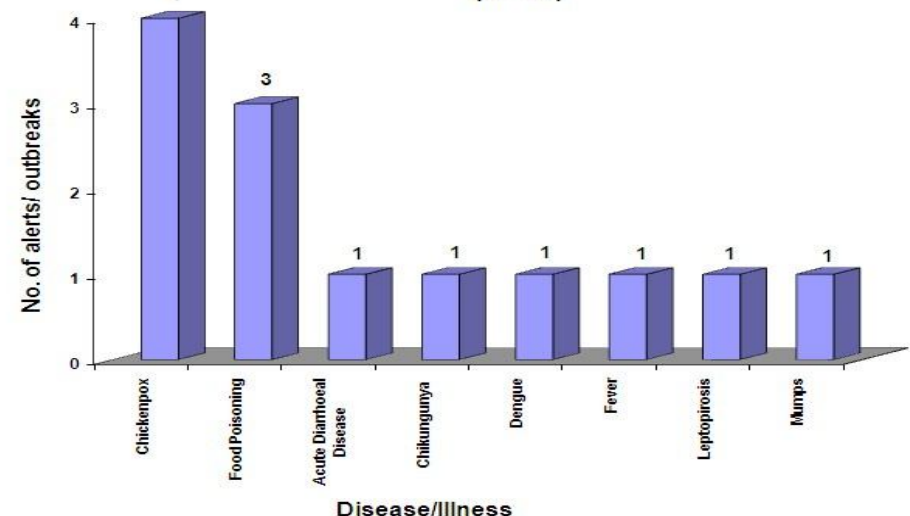

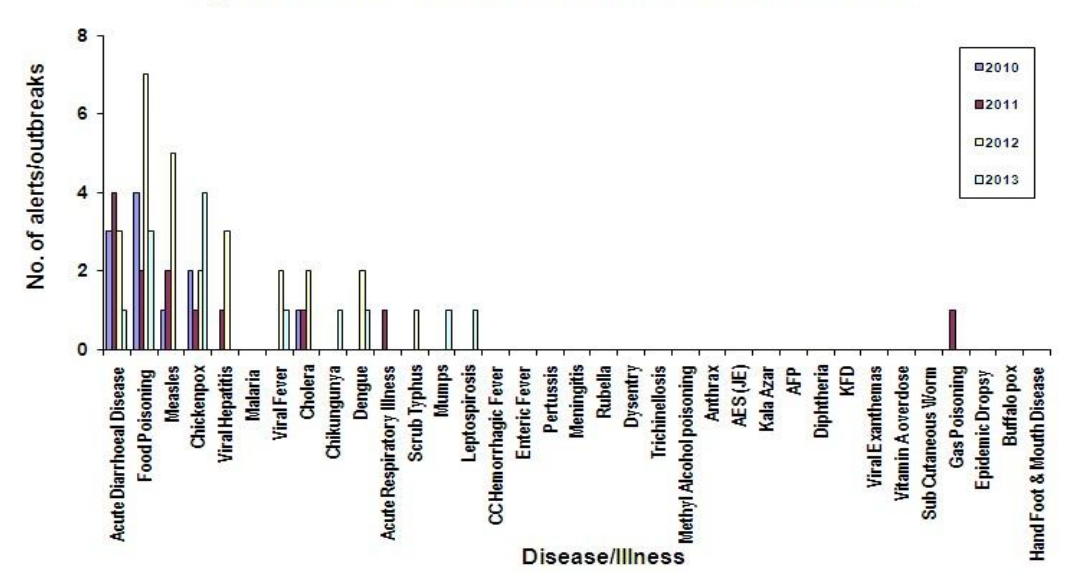

District RRT and Block health team investigated the outbreak. Cases treated at CHC Bassi, SMS Hospital and JK Laun Hospital Jaipur. Health education given.

Medical team investigated the outbreak. House to house survey done by paramedical team. Cases treated symptomatically. IEC done regarding isolation of cases.
