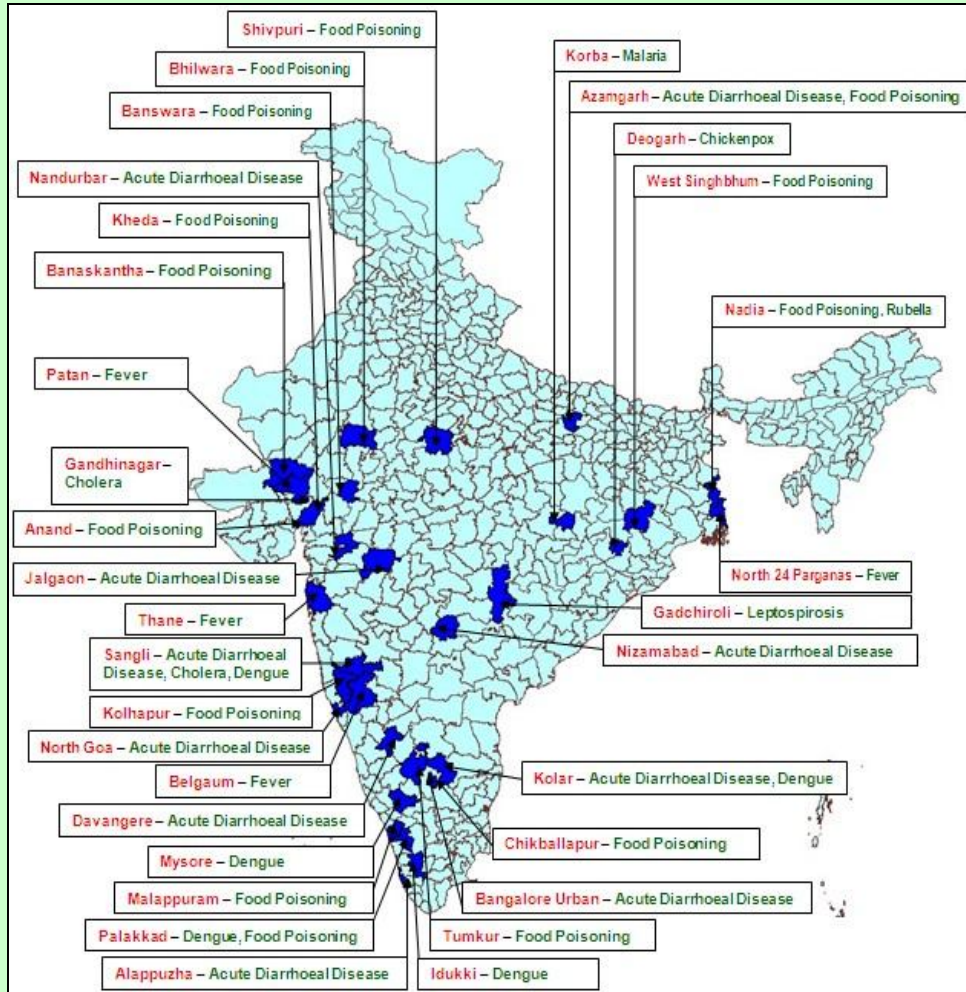


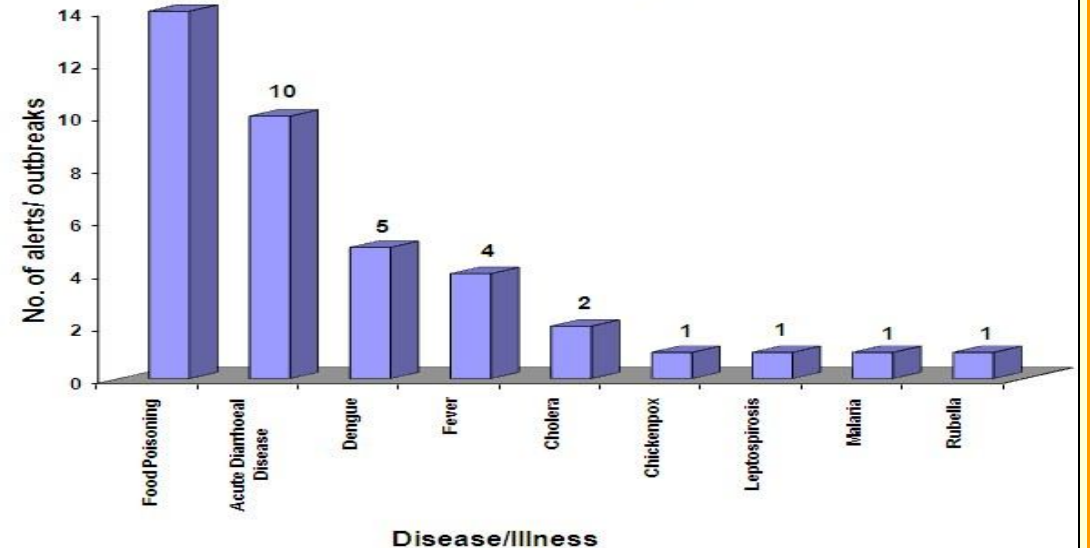

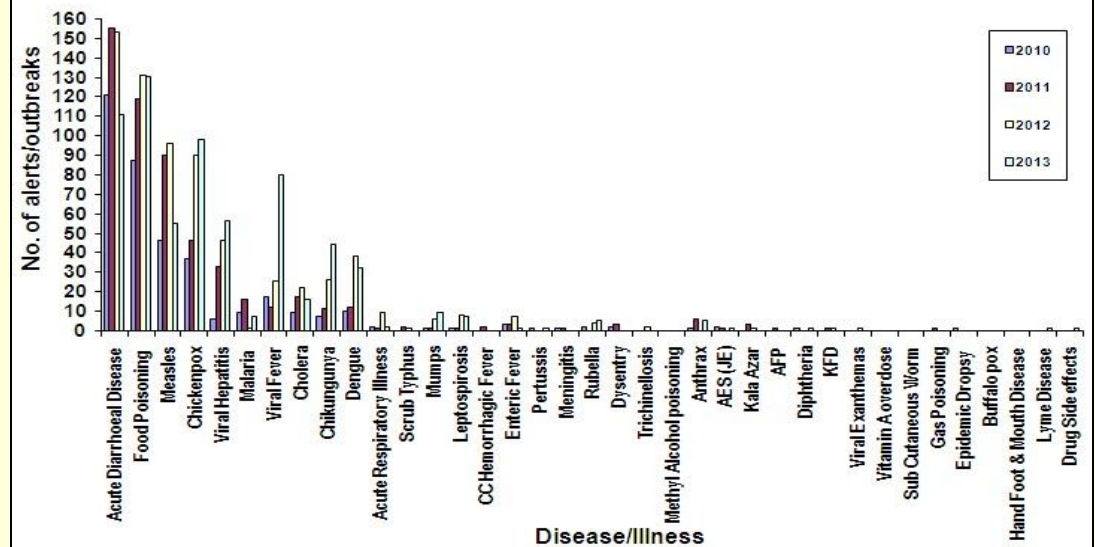
District wise disease alerts/outbreaks reported in the 21st week, 2013
