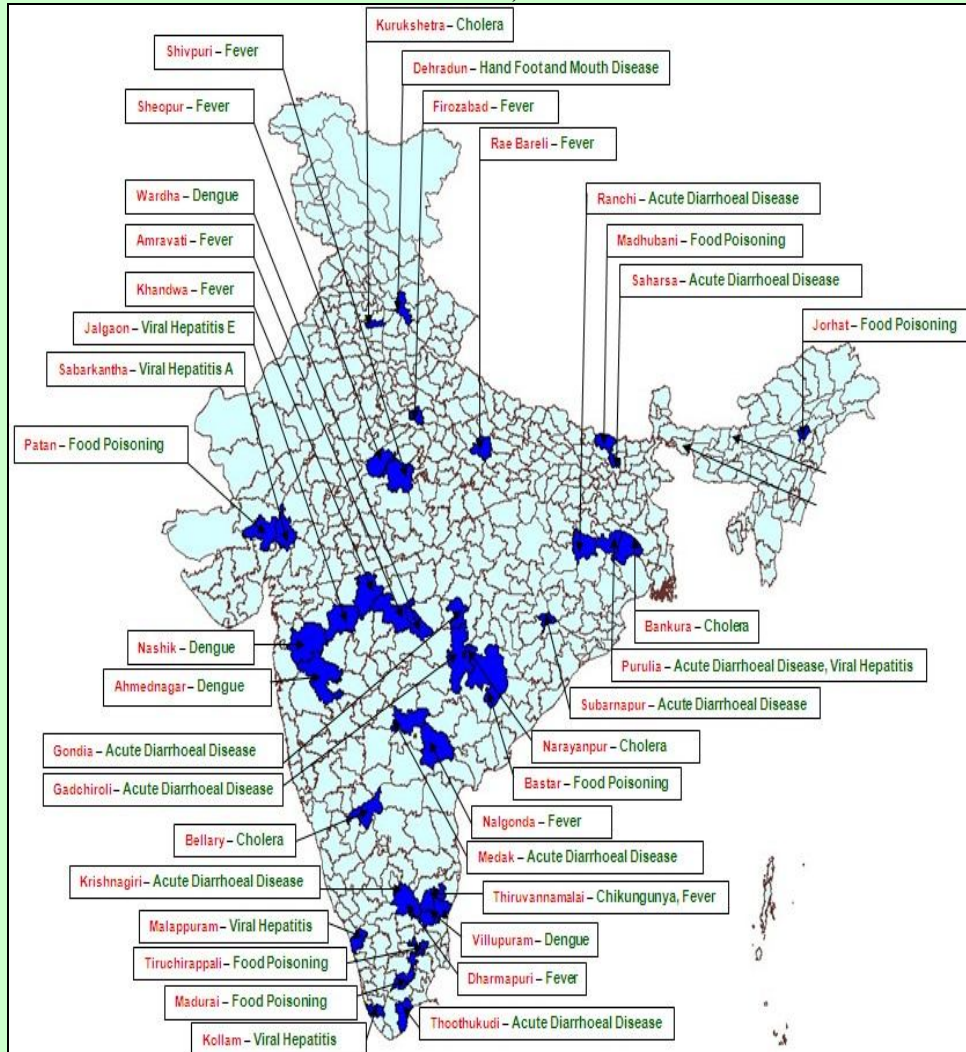
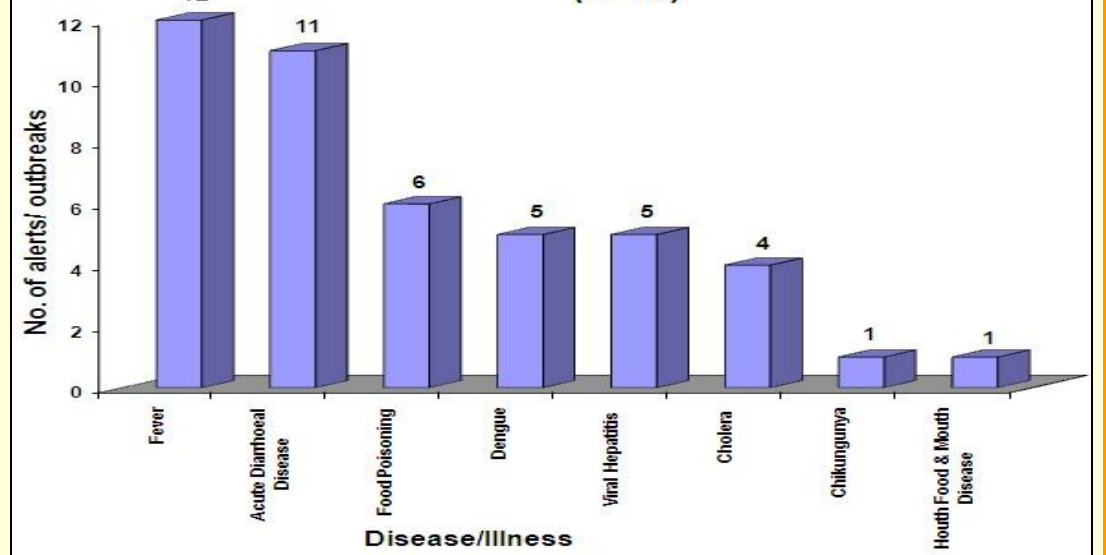


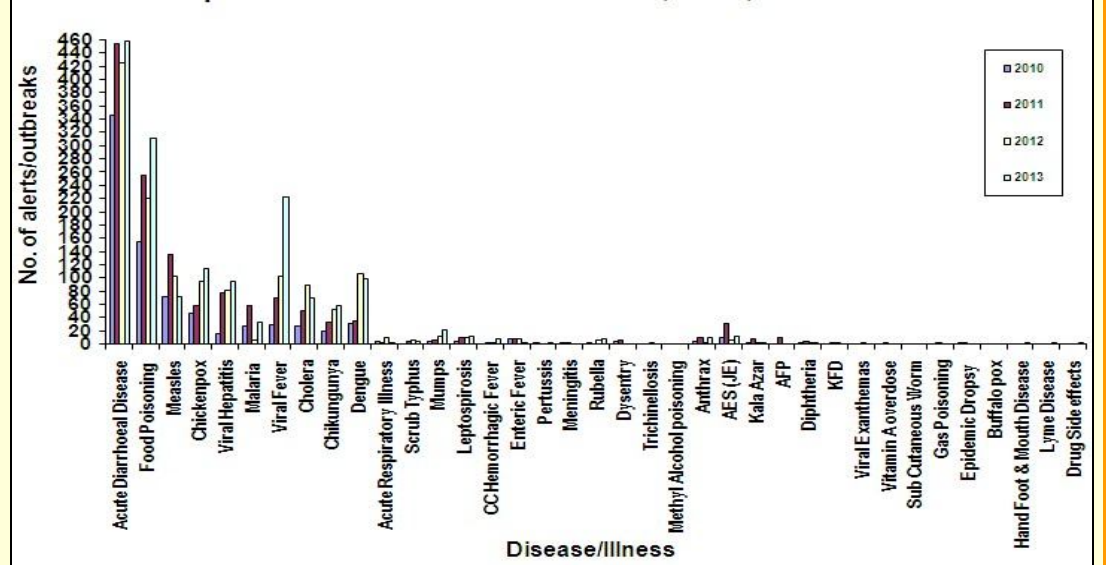

Further, 58 cases occurred from 30 <sup>th</sup> September to 6 <sup>th</sup> October 2013. One death occurred in 5yr old male child. Out of 4 stool samples collected, 3 stool samples were positive for cholera (01 Ogawa). Pipeline leakage repaired. Chlorine tablets and ORS packets distributed. Health education given.
