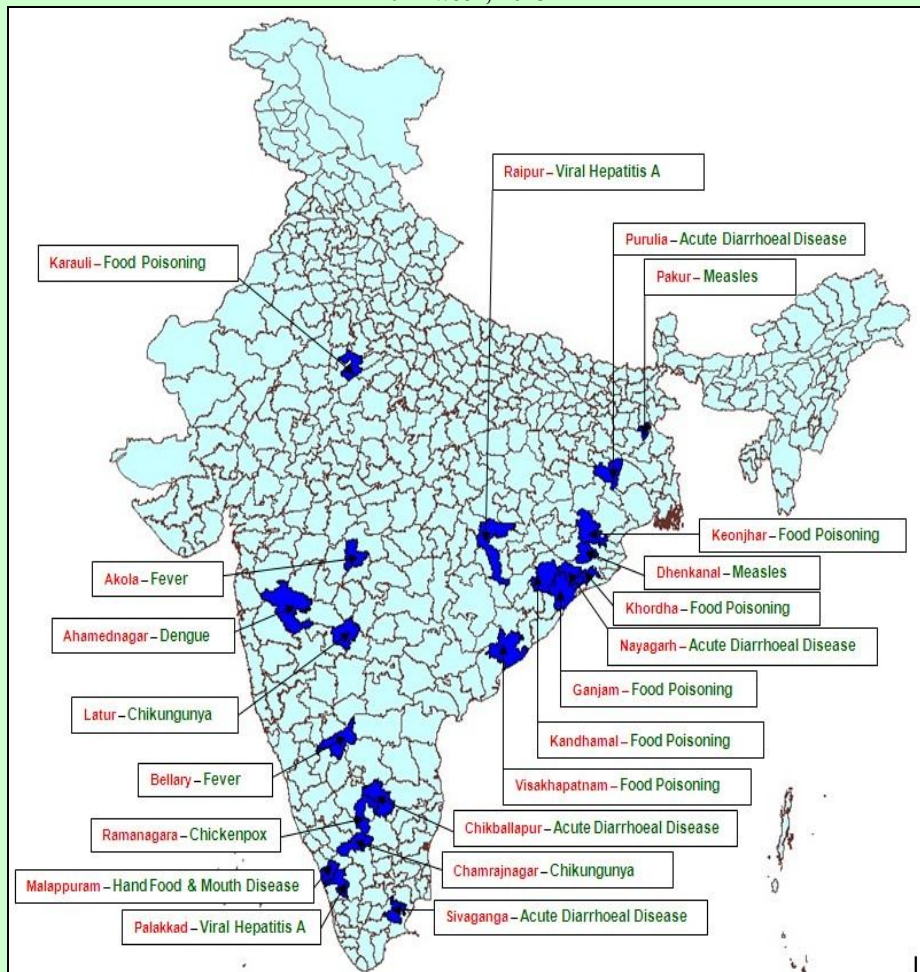




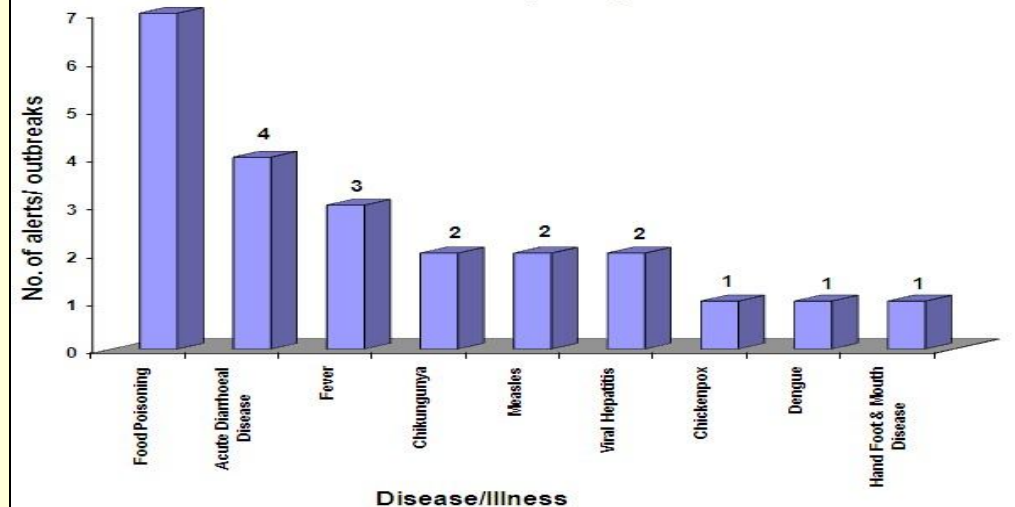

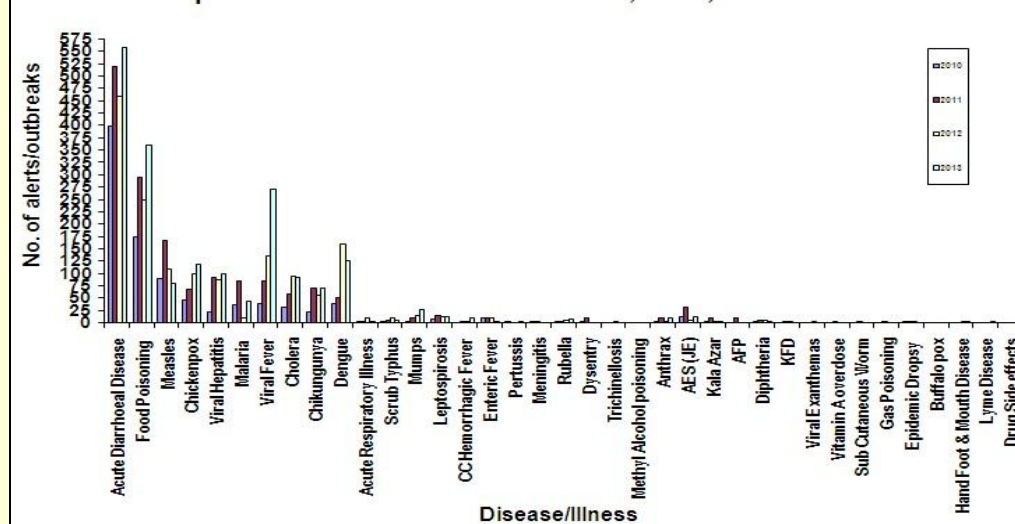
District wise disease alerts/outbreaks reported in the 49th week, 2013

Pipeline leakages were repaired. Health education given regarding use of boiled water for drinking purposes.

Mop up round and ring immunization done.

IEC done regarding hygiene and sanitation and safe water and food consumption.

All cases had attended a social event and consumed meal. District RRT investigated the outbreak. In all, 3 stool samples tested no pathogen found. One water sample tested and found potable. House to house survey done, Chlorine tablets, ORS packets distributed. IEC done regarding hygiene and sanitation and safe water consumption.
