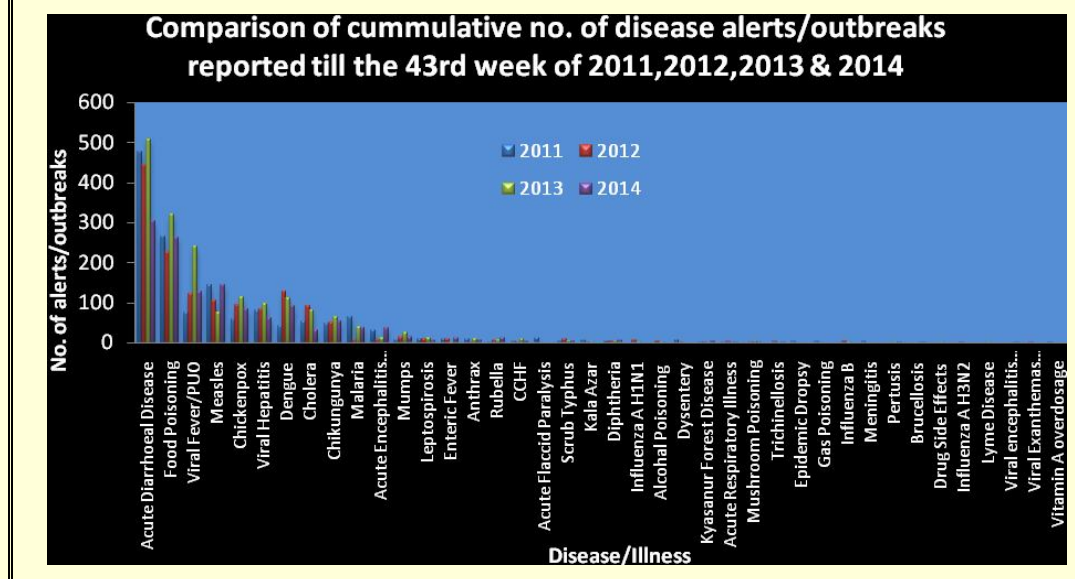
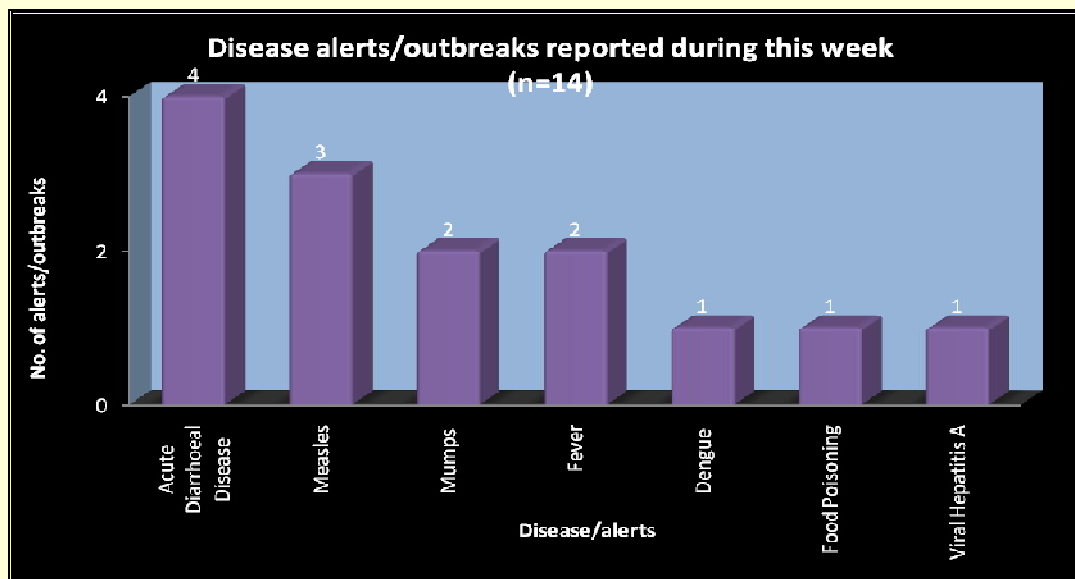
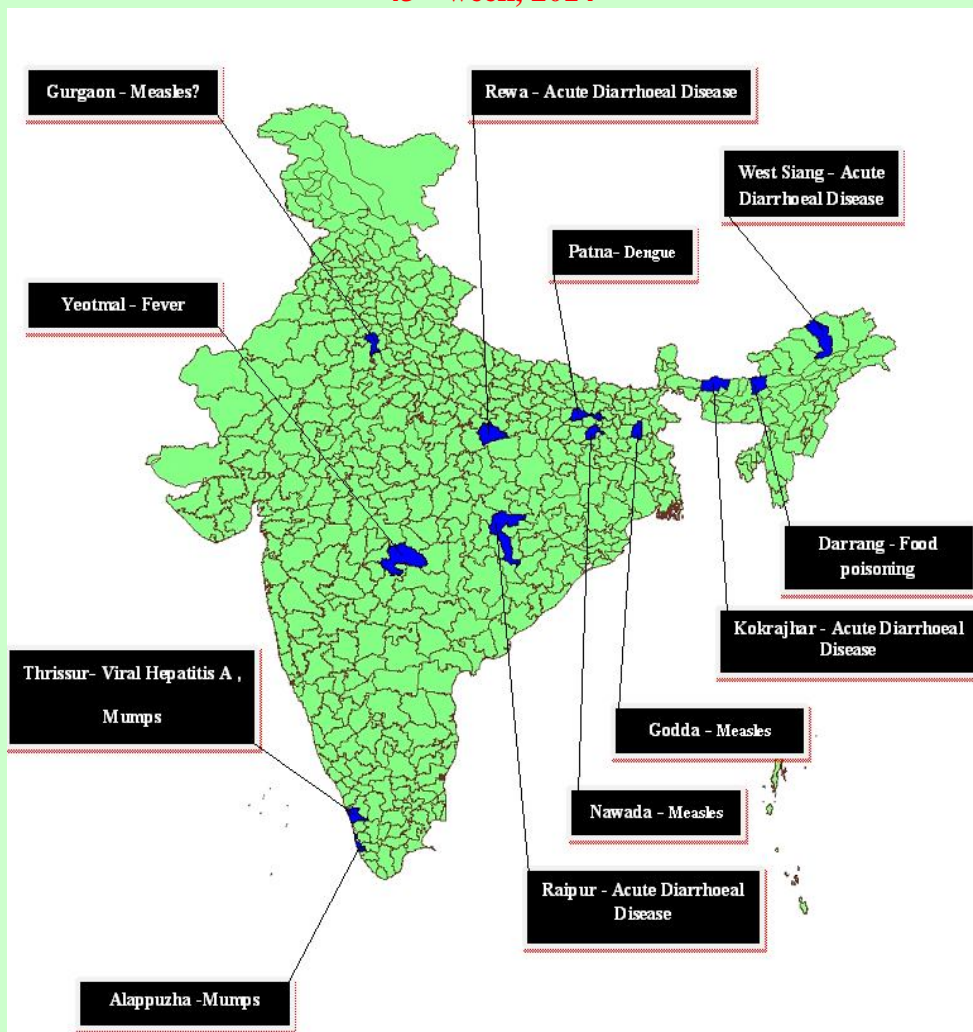

All cases were treated and Vitamin A given to all affected. IEC done regarding isolation and early treatment of cases.

Health education given to the community. All the cases were given Vitamin A for prophylaxis.
