

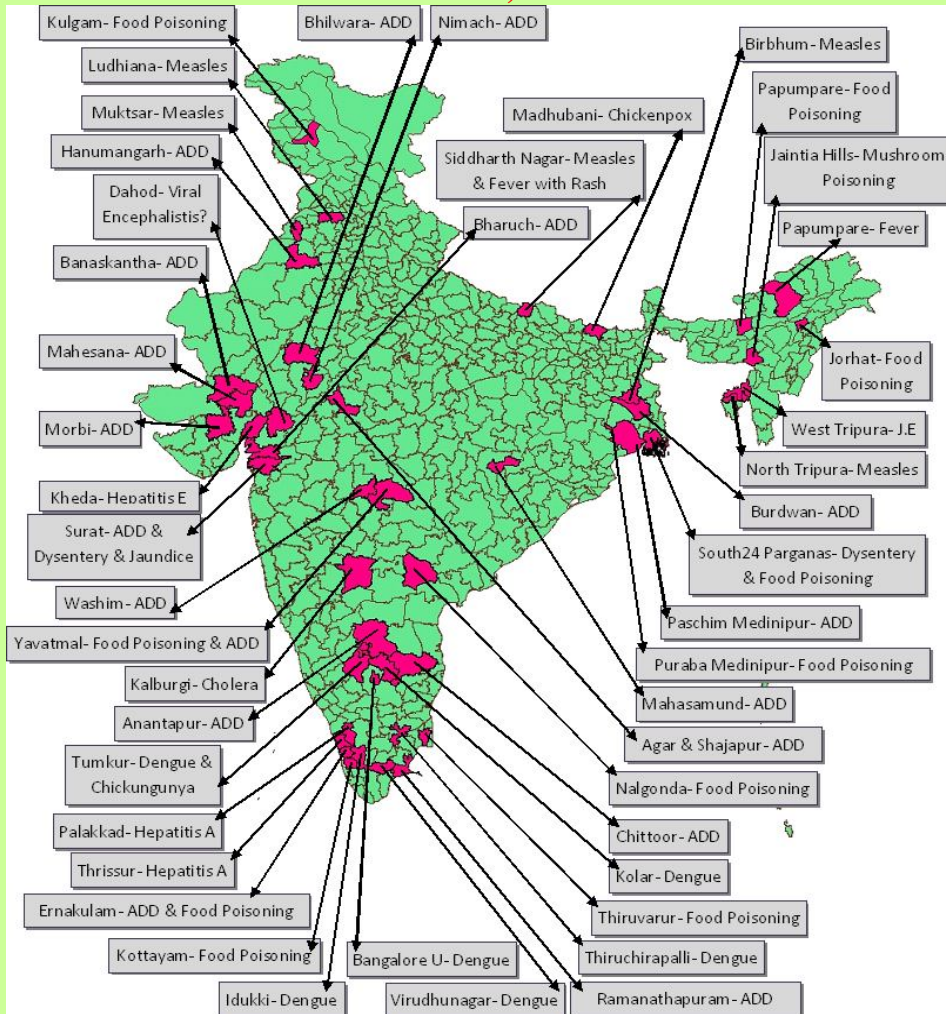

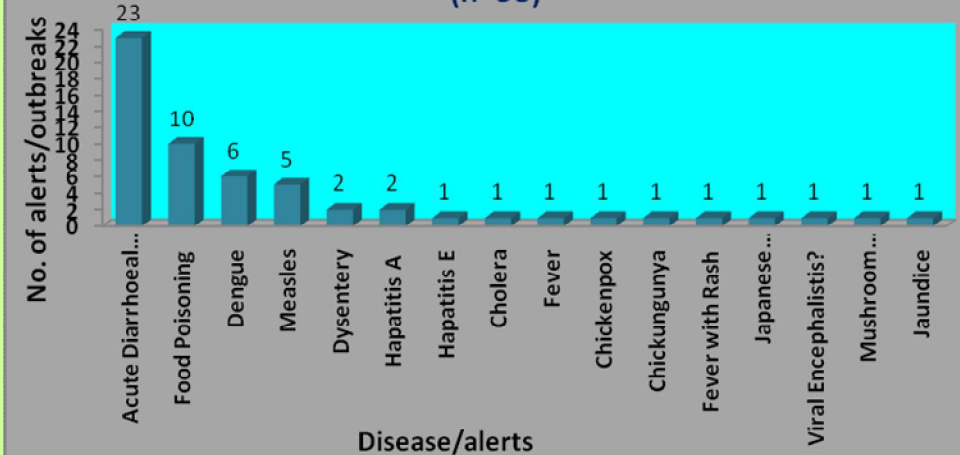

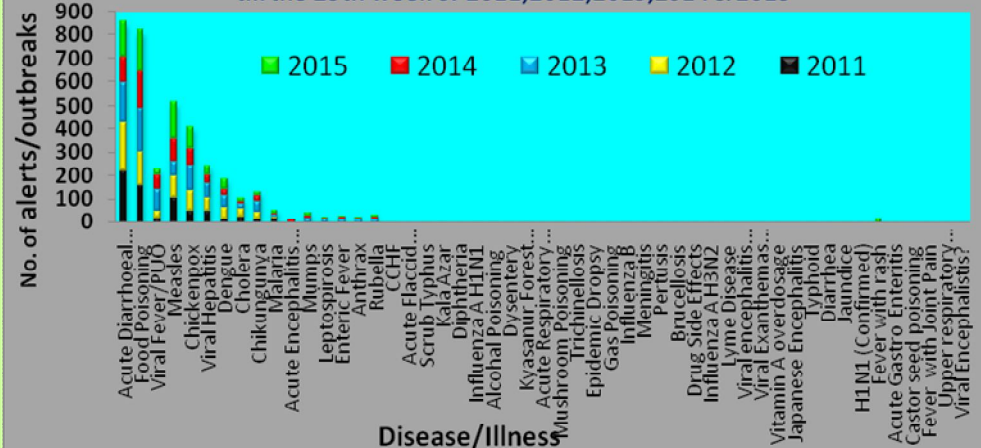
District wise disease alerts/outbreaks reported in the 25th week, 2015
