The weekly vector-borne disease report issued by the civic agency shows one case of dengue being reported in the last week.

The process of data compilation was resumed after a gap due to novel coronavirus pandemic. The report indicates that the initial trends show the magnitude of mosquito-borne diseases may be higher this year. While only one malaria case had been reported till April 18 last year, this year 11 malaria cases have been found so far.

Similarly, in case of chikungunya, 17 cases have been reported so far, while the figure was around 11 during the same period in 2019.
