Subject: Replacement of irreparable ICT Equipment under IDSP (funding approved under NHM- PIP 2016-17 in FMR code no. A.10.8.1) – regarding.

Integrated Disease Surveillance Programme (IDSP) is a program under National Health Mission and I am happy to share that IDSP has completed its 10 years since its inception in 2004. Under IDSP data is collected on epidemic prone diseases on weekly basis (Monday–Sunday). The information is collected on three specified reporting formats, namely “S” (suspected cases), “P” (presumptive cases) and “L” (laboratory confirmed cases) filled by Health Workers, Clinicians and Laboratory staff respectively. The weekly data gives information on the disease trends and seasonality of diseases.

CSU, IDSP receives disease outbreak reports from the States/UTs on weekly basis. Even NIL weekly reporting is mandated and compilation of disease outbreaks/alerts is done on weekly basis. On an average 30-35 outbreaks are reported to CSU weekly. A total 1584 outbreaks in 2012, 1964 outbreaks in 2013, 1562 outbreaks in 2014, 1935 outbreaks in 2015 and 1172 outbreaks reported from 4th January to 15th May 2016. Majority of outbreaks reported were of Chicken Pox (30%), Measles (19%), Food Poisoning (12%) and Acute Diarrheal Disease(13%).

In view of this Information & Communication Technology (ICT) plays important role in data collection, collation, compilation, analysis & dissemination of data and also provides platform in timely detection of outbreaks in early rising phase.

Since the equipment were supplied 8-9 years back they are now working unsatisfactorily and not much work is being taken out from them. The same issue has been raised by States in various review meetings done in the past. Various National and International experts also raised the similar concern during the de-briefing of the Joint Monitoring Mission (JMM) that was held from November – December 2015.

From above, in view of the present advancement of technology, IDSP recommends replacement of irreparable ICT equipment under IDSP in States & Districts for better functioning of the programme.

The approved budget for replacement of ICT equipment under IDSP has been **sanctioned in PIP 2016-17 under FMR Code No. A.10.8.1** (Strengthening of DPMU) as per the proposals from States/UTs in PIPs. ICT equipment can be procured following the DGS&ND rate contract / State procurement procedures

It is therefore, requested if the budget has been approved in ROP of IDSP PIP 2016-17, the funds may be released for respective IDSP divisions of States/Districts
