In yet another tragic incident, a man lost his life and several others fell ill after consuming food at a baby shower function in Tamil Nadu's Tiruvarur. The man reportedly died due to food poisoning. Police have identified the deceased as Selvamurugan.

According to police, Selvamurugan of Velankani was among those who ate biryani at C Vignesh's wedding reception for his wife V Mariammal on Thursday, news agency IANS reported.

Selvamurugan, Mariammal, and many others complained of vomiting and diarrhoea and were admitted to Thiruvarur Government Hospital.

On Thursday, nearly 20 people were admitted to the hospital for better treatment. Selvamurugan died on Friday afternoon, while six people are still being treated at the hospital.

Mariammal, Chandru, Selvaganapathi, Rajamanickam, Balaji, and a four-year-old child are among those receiving treatment at the hospital, IANS reported.

On Friday afternoon, thirteen more people were released from the hospital. The Thiruvarur District Superintendent of Police told reporters that an investigation is underway.

The local health inspection wing of the health department, which is conducting an investigation, visited the location where the food was prepared and collected samples of food particles and cooking water.
