Title:	100 students fell sick due to food poisoning in Maharashtra's Sangli, 20 critical

As many as 100 students of an ashram school for VJNT students from Umadi town of Jat tehsil in Maharashtra's Sangli district were hospitalised due to food poisoning.

Around 20 of them are said to be critical and are admitted in Miraj Civil Hospital.

The poisoning have taken place through the food served on Sunday night, claimed the district health administration.

After the students started complained of uneasiness during midnight hours, they were shifted to primary health centre of the town.

After the recommendations of the doctors, 20 of them who were critically poisoned were transferred to Miraj Civil Hospital where they are kept under observation. The students being treated at PHC Umadi are stable.

District collector Raja Dayanidhi has asked the social welfare department officials to investigate the incident and submit the report in 24 hours.

"We will ensure the students get good medical treatment. We will ensure their safety. I have asked for an investigation into the matter. The action will be taken against those responsible for putting the students through such pain," said Dayanidhi in a statement.
