Title:	70 people fall ill after consuming 'contaminated' food in Golaghat, Assam

As many as 70 persons, including children, were hospitalized after consuming allegedly contaminated food. According to sources, a devotional programme was held in the residence of a resident of Jogeswar Dutta Nagar of Golaghat town under Golaghat police station on May 10. In the programme, more than 70 persons attended and they consumed khichdi, kheer, mixed sabji, gram and fruits.

On May 11, 23 of the persons who had attended the programme developed symptoms such as loose motion, vomiting, fever and headache. After that nine people were admitted in Swahid Kushal Konwar Civil Hospital and two persons were admitted in Golaghat Nursing Home. Sources said that most of the people who had attended the devotional programme are suffering loose motion, vomiting, fever and headache and are under medical supervision. A child is in a critical condition and in the ICU, added sources.
