Title:	People admitted to hospital due to vomiting and diarrhoea in Bidar, Karnataka

Around 27 people are sick due to vomiting and dysentery in Belakera village of Chitaguppa taluk and are being admitted and receiving treatment at the community health center of the town. Out of these 8 people have been sent to Bidar Government Hospital for further treatment.

Most of these cases were found in the new barangay of the village. Apparently, consumption of contaminated drinking water is said to be the cause of the incident. The drinking water has already been sent for testing and the exact reason will be known after receiving the report. Vijayakumar Hariskar has given information.

Those admitted to the hospital are being treated and some have recovered. Some others have been sent to the district hospital. Precautionary measures have been taken in the village. Health workers are giving first aid to the people in the village itself and creating awareness. On Sunday, officials and people's representatives rushed to the hospital and the village to take stock of the situation due to the worsening of vomiting and dysentery.



On Sunday, DHO Dr. Ravikanta Swamy, DSO Dr. Sankara Rao Bomma, Tehsildar Ravindra Dama, T.P. EO Akrampasha, TAHO Dr. Shivakumar Siddeshwar visited and collected information. Visit of Vidhan Parishad members: Dr. Chandrasekhara Patil, Bhimrao Patil, members of Vidhan Parishad rushed to the hospital on Sunday and talked to the patients and gave them courage. Talked to the Chief Medical Officer of the Community Health Center and the District Health and Family Welfare Officer and advised them to provide appropriate treatment. Later he visited Belakera village and inspected the place and took the panchayat officials to task.

Such incidents are happening due to your irresponsibility. He warned them to perform their duties in a good manner. T.P. EO and Tehsildar have created awareness in Chitaguppa town and all the villages of Dangura sari to drink hot water and maintain cleanliness. On this occasion, there were members of the municipality, village council and important people.

MLA Dr. Siddalingappa Patil visited Belakera village and hospital on Sunday and gave courage to the villagers and those undergoing treatment. Care should be taken to ensure that people are not disturbed, and steps should be taken to get immediate treatment. MLAs have given strict instructions to provide clean drinking water and create awareness by prioritizing cleanliness.
