Title:	Lumpy skin disease affects 6,340 animals in 17 districts, Odisha

The state has reported 6,340 cases of lumpy skin disease (LSD) in cattle from 17 districts. Within eight days, around 4,500 more cases have been officially reported.

Ganjam district has reported the highest cases of LSD followed by Bargarh and Balasore. Out of 6,340 LSD cases, Ganjam's share is more than 40 per cent, official sources said.

"LSD is a viral disease. After getting infected by this disease, the cattle gets fever and nodules on its skin. It can be cured with proper treatment. This disease may become dangerous for calves," said an official of the fisheries and animal resources development (FARD) department. On November 30, the state reported 1,865 LSD cases.
