On this he said that we have only 12 beds. We have put the patients in 12 beds and made the rest of the patients lie on the ground. During this, everyone is being treated. Because it is a disaster, the first thing to do is to save the life of the patient. We are doing the same thing first. At present, we have sent information to the CMO and have also informed the police station. Apart from this, information has also been sent to DM Banda. At present, the station in-charge has reached the village and investigated.
