Lizard poisons food at ICDS centre. And that's why more than 50 children are sick. Out of these, 13 children were admitted to Uluberia Saratchandra Medical College Hospital as their physical condition deteriorated.

The incident took place in Syedpur of Dhandali village panchayat of Shyampur police station. It is known that Khichuri was cooked as per the daily routine for the children in Syedpur ACDS School.

School children bring home cooked food. Many children including students felt sick after eating that food.

Parents take sick children to local health centers. Thirteen children have been admitted to Uluberia Saratchandra Medical College Hospital from there.

In this incident, the parents complained that the food prepared in the school was mixed with lizards. Children get sick after eating that food.
