As the summer season has started, Ahmedabadites beware now as the heat in Ahmedabad city has seen a huge increase in the cases of diarrhea and vomiting. Around 100 cases of diarrhea and vomiting are being reported in the city every day. In which an average of 25 people are admitted to the hospital every day. Due to the extreme heat of summer and the increase in diseases, cases of diarrhea and vomiting have increased. There has been an increase in cases of heat-related cases like abdominal pain, fainting, dizziness etc.

As the temperature increases, the disease increases

Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation Health Department Head Dr. Bhavin Solanki said that as the summer heat is increasing, around 100 cases of diarrhea and vomiting are being reported daily in various urban and community health centers of Ahmedabad city. day. Cases of water borne diseases such as diarrhoea, vomiting, jaundice etc. are seen due to heat. Heat-related cases in which the person is exposed to the sun more frequently have increased cases of headaches, dizziness, fainting etc.

ORS packets are distributed

by Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation during summer season under hit action plan. Planning is done to ensure that everyone has access to drinking water. In which about 30,000 ORS packets have been distributed to all urban and community health centers. About 800 construction sites have been provided with drinking water.

7-7 cases of hit stroke reported

In the last 14 days, Ahmedabad city has reported 1010 cases of abdominal pain, 658 cases of fainting, 485 cases of diarrhea vomiting and 331 cases of fever. According to 108 emergency services, cases of heat-related illnesses have increased in the second week of May this year compared to May last year. In the last two days, 7-7 cases of stroke have been reported in the state.

...then report to 108

According to the 108 emergency service, when anyone feels overheated, fainting or fainting, report to the 108 emergency service so that the person can be treated immediately. In many cases, people take them to the hospital in private vehicles, but if they seek 108 emergency help, they get immediate treatment there. 108 Training has also been given to all the personnel working in the emergency ambulance service on how to treat cases of heat-related diseases, keeping in mind the heat.
