30 students of a residential school in Vijayapura were admitted to hospital due to food poisoning. The students of Kasturbagandhi Girls Residential School in Raksagi fell ill.

After eating from the hostel on Monday afternoon, he felt unwell. Doctors said that the health condition of the students undergoing treatment at Muddebihal Taluk Hospital is satisfactory. Tehsildar said that the real cause of food poisoning will be known only after receiving the report from the laboratory.

Meanwhile, it is alleged that a lizard was found in the food. On Monday afternoon, the students were served the usual food. After some time after eating, some students vomited and complained of headache. In the evening, 30 students fell ill. Then he was admitted to the hospital.
