Many students of the girls' high school in nearby Kembavi town fell ill after consuming hot food (uppittu) on Saturday morning and were admitted to the Community Health Centre. It is said that the lizard was lying dead in the lunch distributed to the students in the school on Saturday morning. It is learned that more than 200 students have consumed the food. Out of which 4 to 5 students are sick due to vomiting. More than 150 students received first aid at the town's Community Health Centre. Students and parents are panicking and rushing to the hospital.

My daughter came home from school looking tired. After some time she vomited twice. Muthurja Teli, the parent of the student Alia, said that she panicked at home and was taken to the government hospital.

In the morning I found a lizard's tail on my plate while eating it. Immediately informed the helper. He asked to spill the salt outside. The students said that by then many students had eaten uppitta.
