At least 150 people were taken ill after allegedly consuming stale food at a religious function organised in Kherli area of Alwar district late on Tuesday night.

The patients were rushed to Kherli's government-run hospital for treatment and some of them were rushed to district hospital in Alwar. "Four persons were admitted to Alwar's district hospital. All the patients are stable. The patients were admitted with complaints of vomiting and diarrhoea caused by eating stale food," said Dr Sriram Sharma, chief medical health officer, Alwar.

At Kherli's government hospital, due to inflow of patients, the number of beds were not found sufficient to accommodate them. With limited resources for accommodating the patients, doctors rushed to help them. The patients continued pouring in at the hospital's emergency unit. More than one patient was adjusted in one bed. Besides, doctors kept monitoring health of the patients and those required intravenous fluid due to dehydration, were administered drips.
