Nine girl students from different parts of Madhya Pradesh, who were traveling by train from Amritsar to their state, fell ill and had to be hospitalised due to symptoms like vomiting and dizziness, which were attributed to food poisoning.

The authorities at the local civil hospital reported that the admitted students are now in stable condition.

According to Manish Soni, the Block Coordinator of Khel Yiva Kalyan Vibhag, a group of 122 girls from various districts of Madhya Pradesh, accompanied by 14 officials, had embarked on a five-day tour. During their visit to Amritsar, they visited places like the Wagah Border and other areas before their return journey on Wednesday.



The coordinator further explained that they boarded the train from Amritsar to Bhopal at 8.50am. To satisfy their hunger, they had purchased packed food from a hotel in Amritsar, which included items like rice, curd, potato vegetables, and pickles. At around 11am, the students were provided with the food, but within ten minutes, they began experiencing health issues.
