An incident took place in Karakyala village under Ekamba village of Aurad taluk where more than 20 people from three or four families including three children fell ill and were admitted to the hospital after drinking contaminated water.

A pipe used to supply water from a well above the village lake in the background to solve the problem of drinking water in the village. It is being said that the reason for this incident is the bad condition of the line.

Officials who rushed to the spot and inspected, found that water was supplied to these three or four houses from a tubewell near the house, and there was a special A pipeline has been made for this. This pipeline passed through the drain and the incident of water pollution took place here. It is said that the sick person has been admitted to the taluk hospital and is recovering. District Panchayat CEO Shilpa M. After speaking, it was found that the pipeline was in poor condition. However, he said that after conducting all kinds of water inspections, if any fault is found, disciplinary action will be taken against the concerned.
