36 children fell ill with vomiting and dysentery after eating the hot lunch of Palau at Chikkamallur Government Primary School of the taluk on Tuesday afternoon.

Some children vomited in the school premises and some at home. The parents immediately admitted the children to Shiggavi Government Hospital.

There is no problem with the children. Acidity problem has arisen due to sitting in one place for too long after eating. There is no need to be afraid," said Hanumanthappa, chief doctor of the government hospital.

"There is no problem with hot food. The problem has arisen because the children developed acidity after the meal," said District Collector Raghunandana Murthy.
