Panic continued to grip the residents of Sundargarh district after 11 more cases of dengue, the mosquito-borne disease, surfaced in the district. The hike in the number of the mosquito-borne disease has turned the situation into an epidemic. The number of persons affected by dengue rose to 39 in Khatkurbahal village of Kutra block. Similarly, a total of 41 persons have been tested positive of the disease in the district.

Meanwhile, at least 33 affected persons have been admitted to district headquarters hospital. With this, the dengue patients continue to get admitted to SCB Medical College and Hospital in Cuttack, sources said.
