In a village here, about 20 people became ill after drinking polluted water from a well. Officials gave this information on Tuesday.

Of these, five including two children have been admitted to the district hospital for treatment. The incident is being told of Niyamatpur village of Kokhraj police station area.

Chief Medical Officer Dr Kamal Chandra Rai said that the well is the only source of water in the area and it has become polluted.

He told that on Monday, about 20 people started complaining of vomiting and diarrhea, after which a team of doctors was sent there and treatment was started. He said that bleaching powder has been sprayed in the wells and drains of the village.

He said that the District Panchayat Raj Officer has been asked to supply water in tankers till the well water is treated.
