At least ten children were hospitalised after they consumed milk and eggs at an anganwadi center in Laveru mandal in the district on Saturday. Of the ten, the condition of two children are said to be critical.

According to sources, children in an anganwadi center at Neteru village in Lakshmipuram panchayat of Laveru mandal started vomiting after consuming the milk and eggs. They fell unconscious a few minutes later and were admitted to RIMS in Srikakulam town.

Some parents alleged they received a message from the center saying their children vomited. The children Landa Dhanush, K Mahesh, B Uday Kirna, B Rohini, A Satwik, A Vishnu Vardhan, A Rama Lakshmi, B Sirisha, B Jhansi, and V Sandip were taken to the hospital. Of them, the condition of Jhnasi and Sirisha is said to be serious.

Meanwhile, the parents staged protest in front of the anganwadi center. Etcherla MLA Gorle Kiran Kumar visited the hospital.
