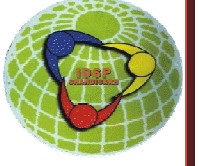

Seven workers fell ill, three of them seriously, after being exposed to poisonous gas that leaked from a paper mill in the industrial district of Raigarh in Chhattisgarh on Wednesday.

The accident happened when workers were cleaning the paper plant, in Tetla village, in preparation for its reopening after the lockdown. It was to renew production after the state government relaxed lockdown restrictions. During the cleanup operation, seven workers fell unconscious and the others complained of uneasiness.
