Virudhunagar district is affected by viral fever due to climate change, from children to the elderly.

Due to the irregular weather conditions such as the rains that have fallen in the district for the past few days and the scorching sun, many people are suffering from fever due to the spread of diseases and viral infections.

As a result, more and more patients have started coming to government and private hospitals for treatment of ailments such as fever, cold and cough.

Ramachandran's daughter Krithika Sri, 11, from Perumal Koil Street, Virudhunagar, studied 6th standard in a private school. A few days ago he suffered from viral fever and died in the Madurai Government Hospital without treatment. Similarly, deaths have occurred due to mysterious fever in many parts of the district.

District Health Department Deputy Director Yashoda said: In Virudhunagar, the municipality has instructed to carry out cleaning work in the area. We are taking steps to prevent the spread of disease by conducting special medical camps.
