Many people are in the grip of chicken pox in Bairiya village of CHC Ramiyabehad. A 35-year-old youth suffering from this has died. Due to this, the family members of other infected people are in panic. Asha and ANM did not even inform the officials about this.

For the last several days, many people in Bairia village are infected with chicken pox. There, many people are said to be in the grip of fever. From children suffering from chicken pox to adults, red rash has emerged on the body. Suffering from this, 35-year-old Kamal Khan's son Akbal Khan had high fever a few days back and rashes appeared on his body. When his health worsened, the family members were taking him to the district hospital for treatment on Saturday night. But Kamal Khan died near Sharda Nagar.

On the other hand, village residents Sanjeev, Reshma, Harshit, Shraddha, Ashish, Kanti, Manvi, Prateek, Sushila, Rajvi, besides Meraj and Ali Ahmed, etc., are suffering from chicken pox. Due to Kamal's death, his family members are in panic.
