With spike in temperatures, waterborne diseases in the city are also on the rise. City hospitals have registered 197 cases of diarrhoea in the first week of this month against just 4 cases in the entire May last year. Similarly, hospitals recorded 54 cases of typhoid during May 1 to May 7 period against 17 cases in May last year. Jaundice cases in the city in the same period stood at 23, same as last year May. AMC health department data showed that vector-borne cases were slightly up against May last year. City hospitals registered 16 cases of malaria in the first week this month against just six in the entire May last year.
