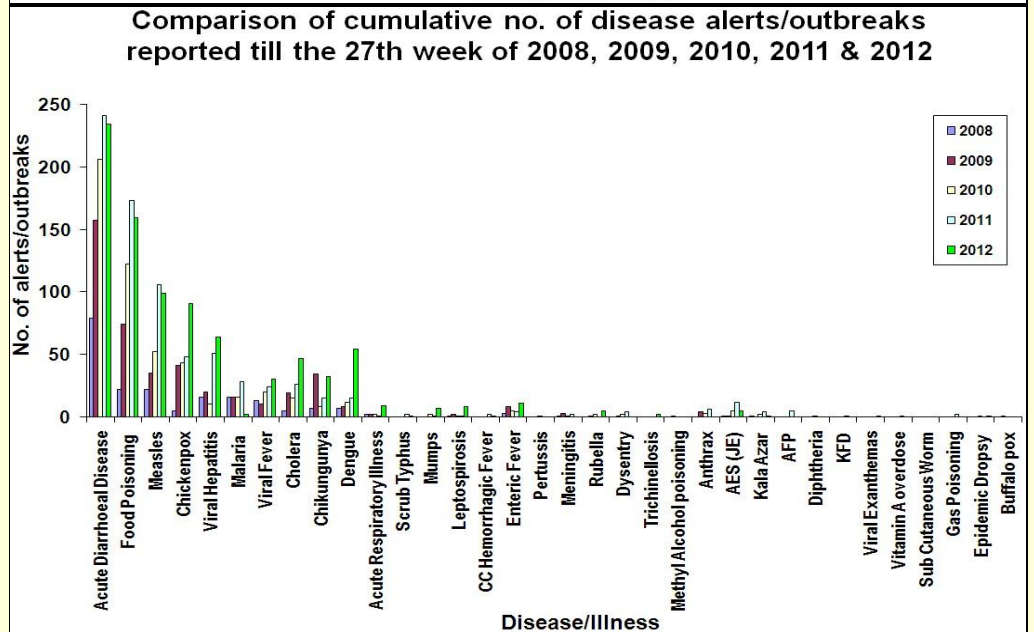
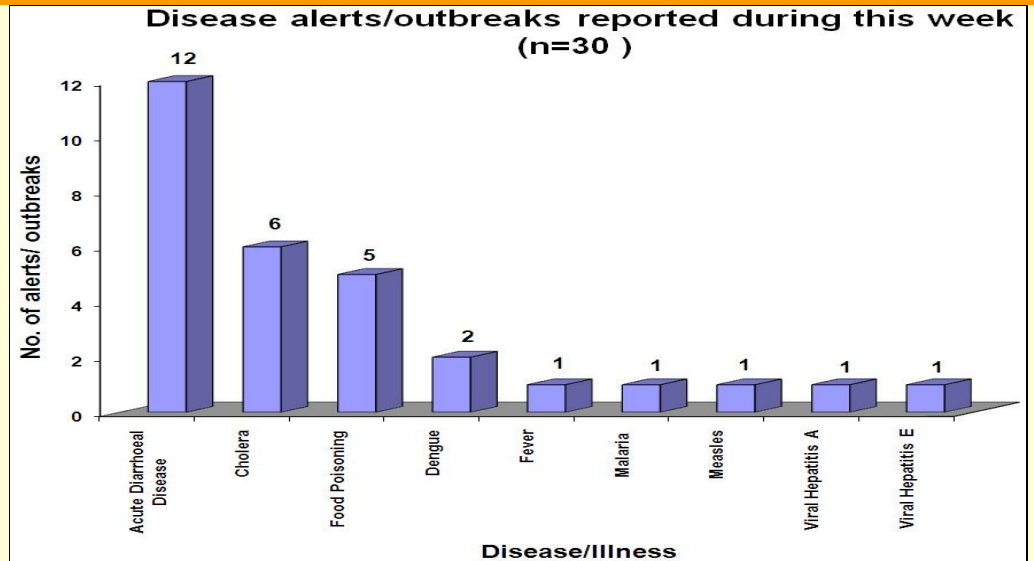
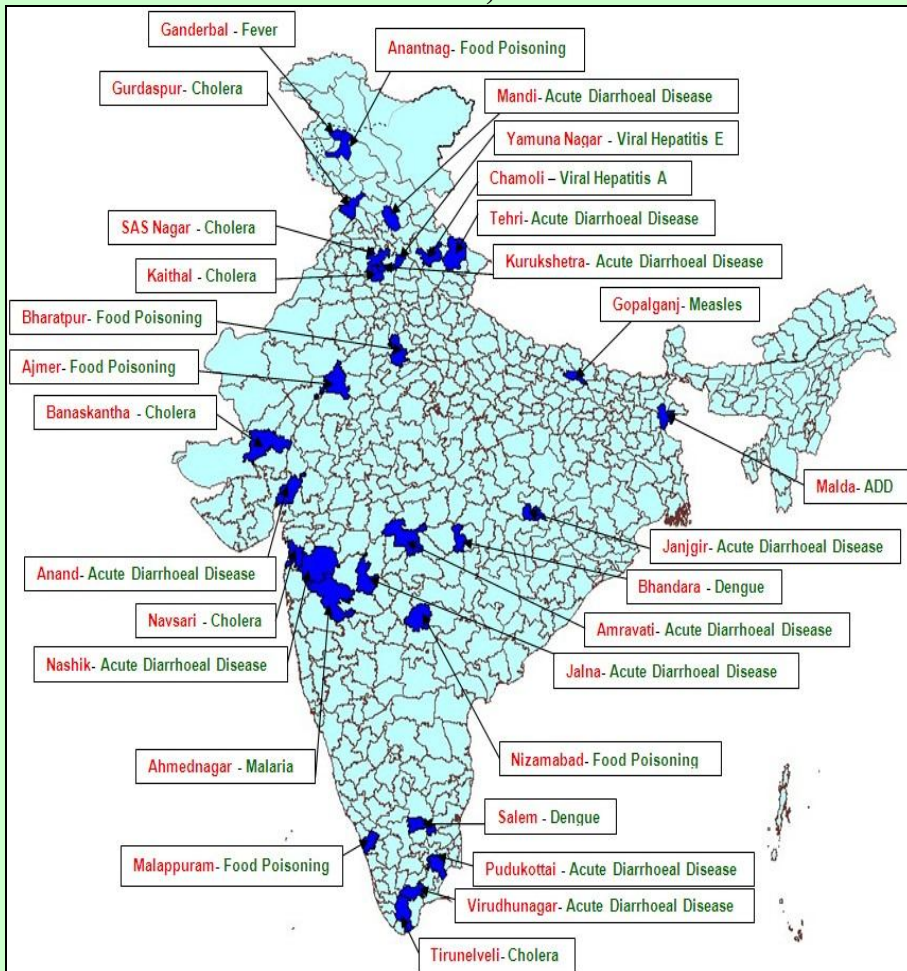

Medicines provided to all cases. Chlorine tablets & ORS packets distributed in the locality. 8 pipeline leakage sites repaired by PHED department. IEC activities done.

Alternate drinking water supply made available. Chlorine tablets & ORS packets distributed on house to house visit. Pipe line leakage repaired. IEC activities done.

House to house survey done. Alternate drinking water supply provided. Health camp organized in the affected area and treatment of all patients done. Chlorine tablets and ORS packets distributed. Education about healthy eating habits done.
