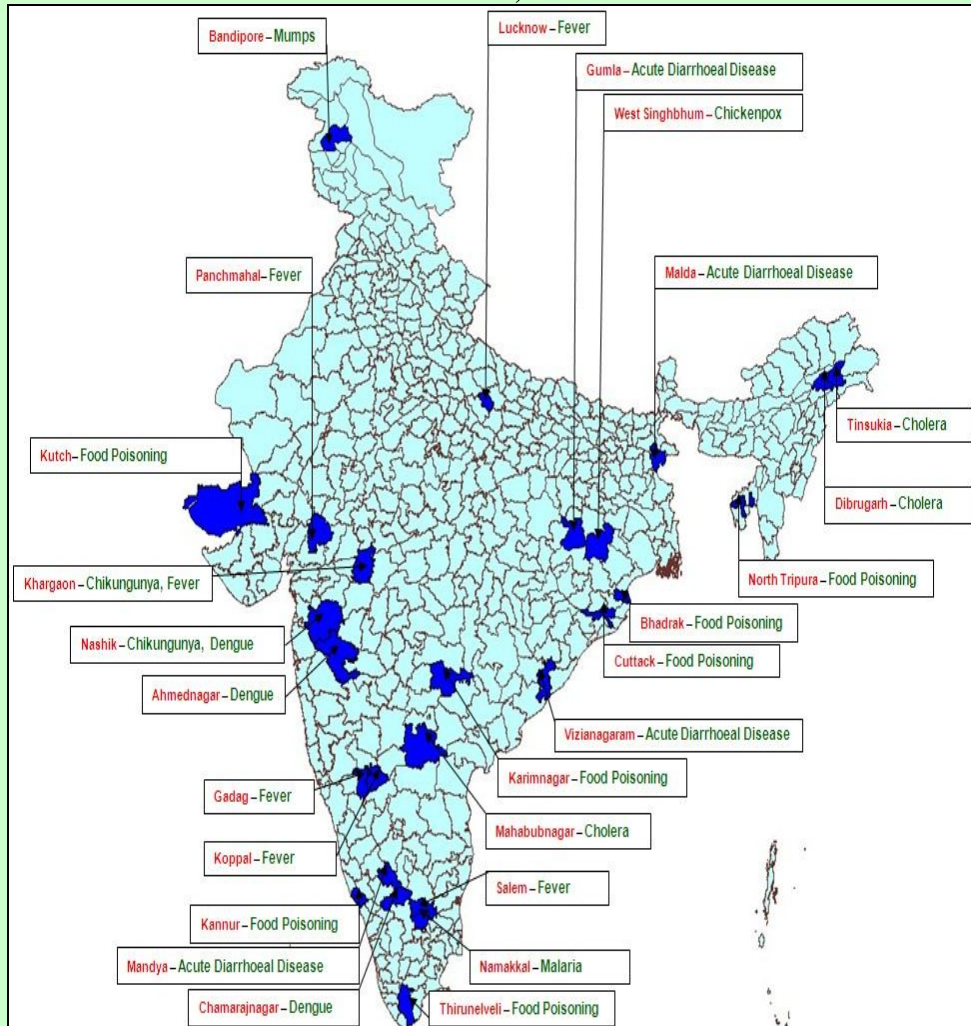

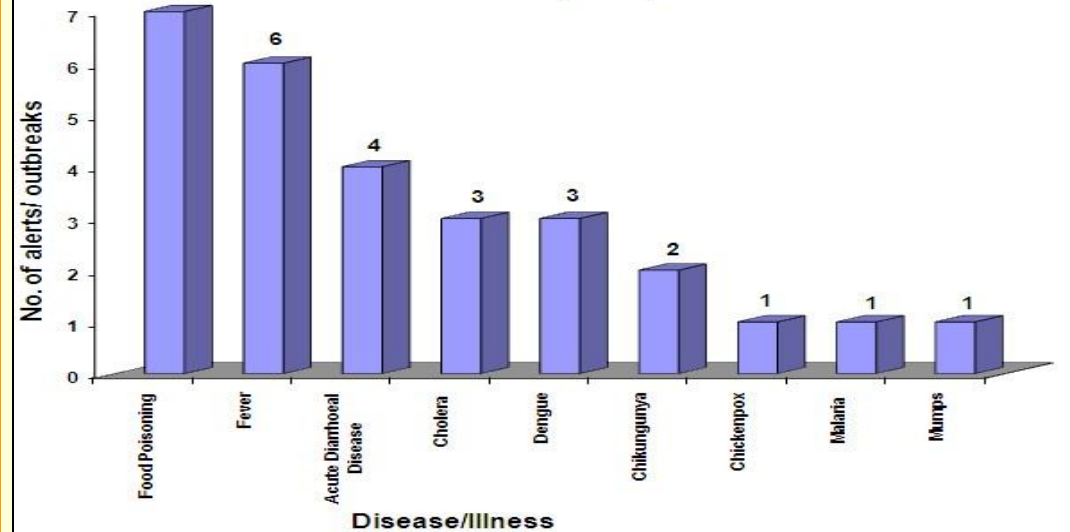

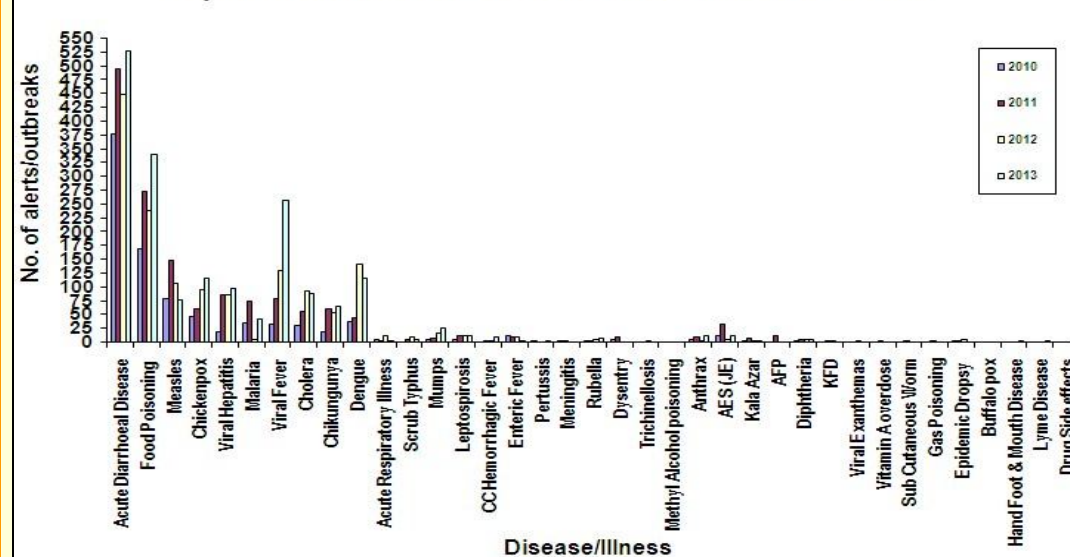
District wise disease alerts/outbreaks reported in the 45th week, 2013
