




District wise disease alerts/outbreaks reported in the 48th week, 2013

House to house survey done. Out of 1836 blood slides collected 102 were positive for malaria (70 P falciparum, 32 P vivax). One death occurred in a pregnant female aged 30. All cases treated locally. Antilaraval activities (temephos and Guppy fishes introduced in water bodies) and fogging done. Health education given.
