







### District wise disease alerts/outbreaks reported in the 6<sup>th</sup> week, 2014

Gram Panchayat was sensitized regarding prevention and control measures. Health education given regarding personal protection.

Health camp organized in the village. Symptomatic treatment given to cases. Alternate drinking water sources provided. Chlorination of water sources done. Health education regarding safe drinking water, hygiene and sanitation.
