

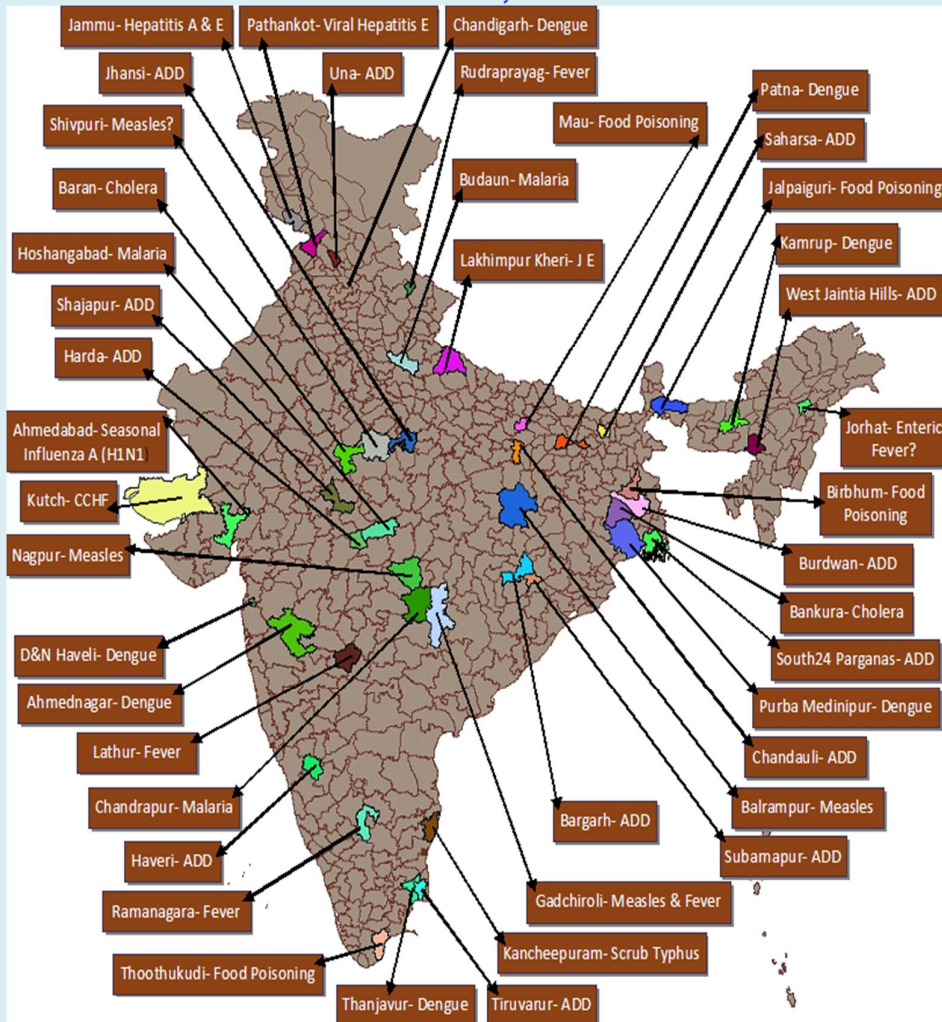

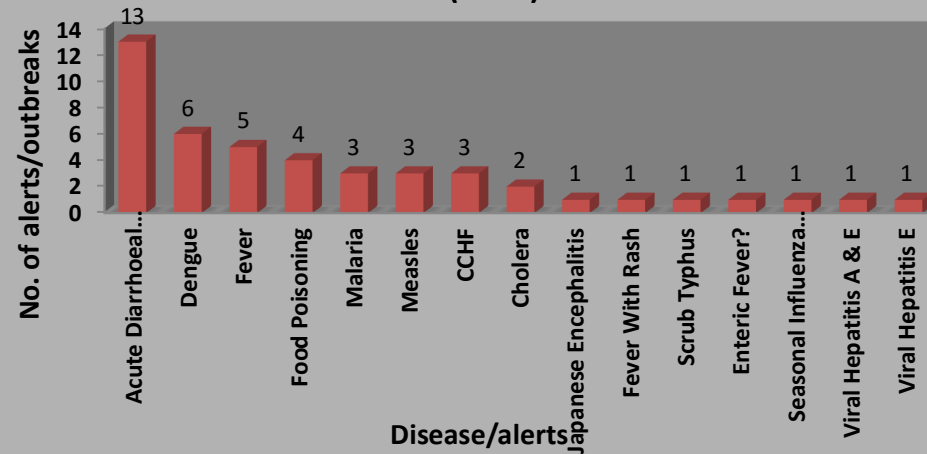

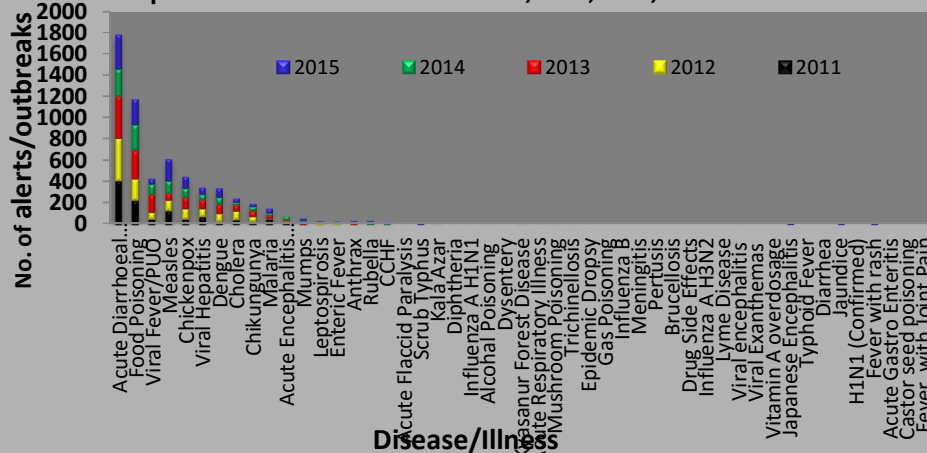
District wise disease alerts/outbreaks reported in the 36th week, 2015
