

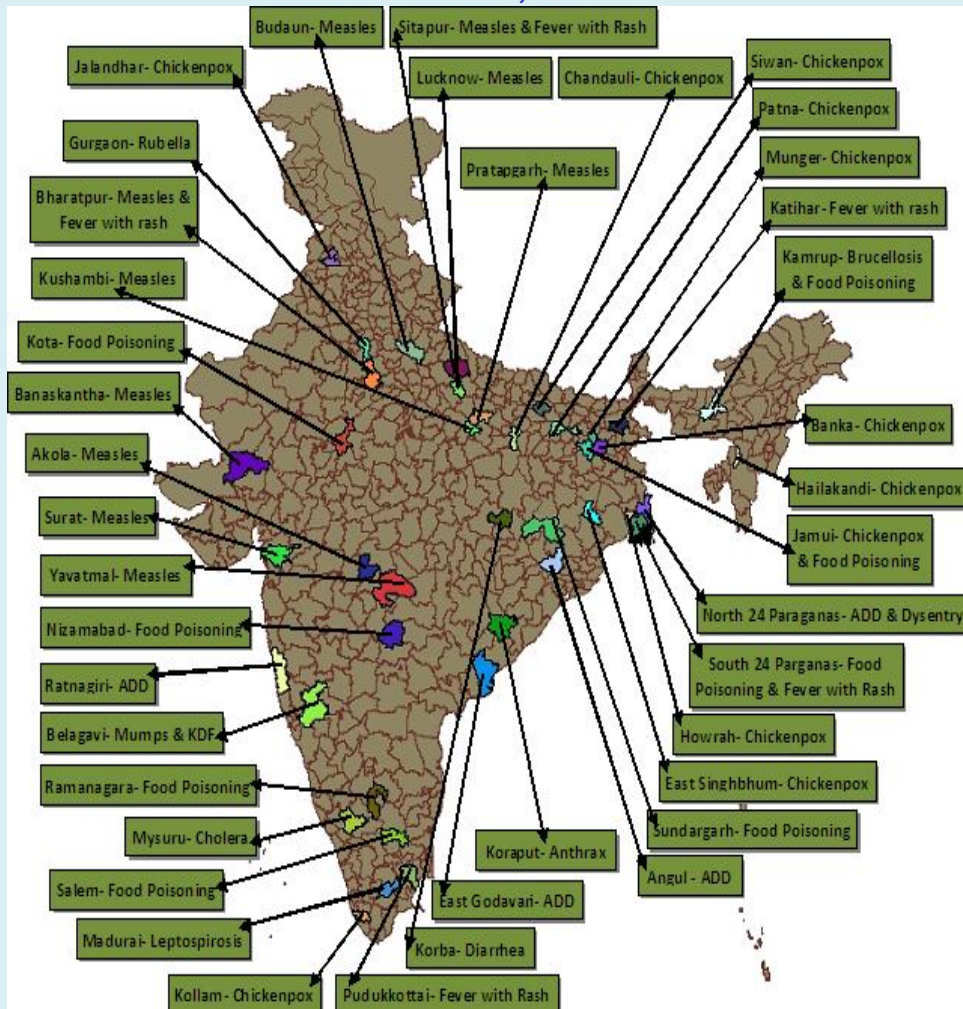

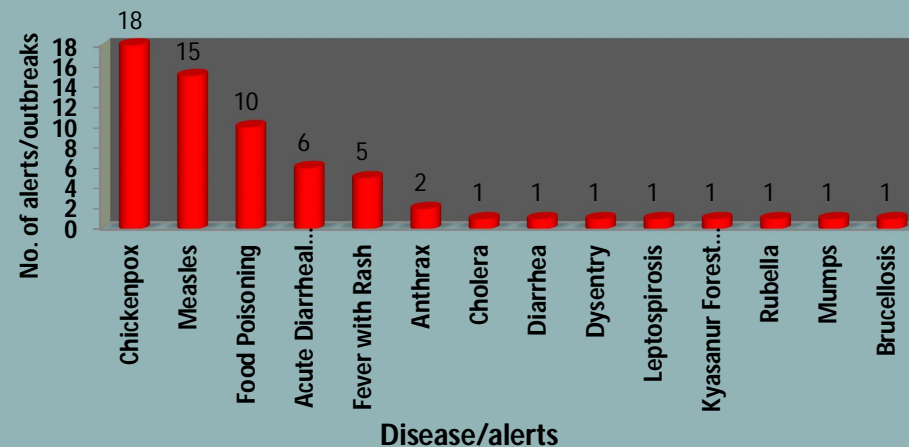

District wise disease alerts/outbreaks reported in the 10th Week, 2016

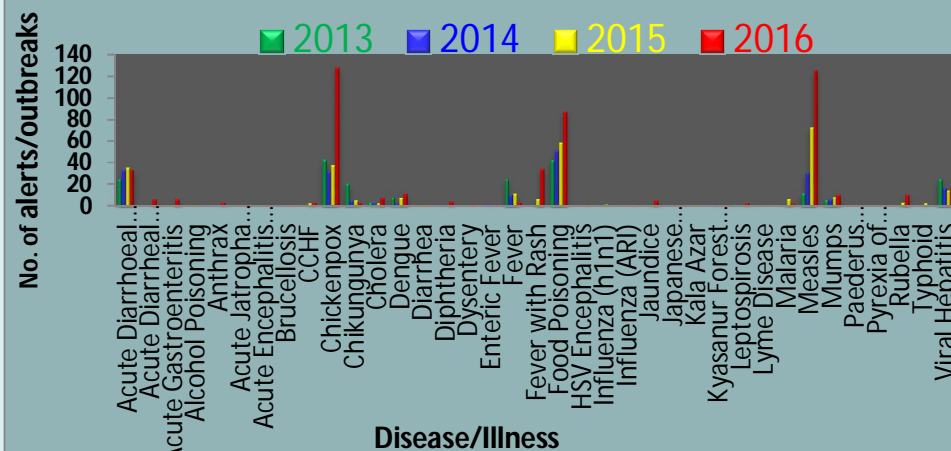


Disease alerts/outbreaks reported during this week
