Title:	Jaipur accounts for 42% dengue cases in Rajasthan

It's shocking but true that in the state, 42% dengue cases were reported from Jaipur alone during the past eight months. In the last seven days, 22 dengue cases were reported across the state but 11 of them belonged to Jaipur.

Not a single week has passed from January till date in which no dengue case was reported in the city. It seems that dengue has become a round-the-year disease for Jaipurites.

The year started off with 48 cases in first week and in the second week of the year, 90 cases were reported. Since then, cases of dengue are constantly being reported.

However, there is a silver lining. Last week, only 11 cases of dengue were reported, which were lowest among all the 31 weeks since January. The cases were reported ranging from 11 to 90 every week.

"The cases of dengue are constantly on the decline not only in Jaipur but also in the state. We have taken series of measures over the past few months, which have helped us bringing down the cases," said Dr Ravi Mathur, additional director (rural

health), health department.

However, he added that recently the health department has declared dengue as a notifiable disease, which will help in registering each and every case of dengue across the state. "Each and every case of dengue will be registered in the state. Directions have been issued to all chief medical health officers to hold meetings with wing of Indian Medical Association in their respective districts so that doctors treating dengue and diagnostic laboratories report each dengue case reported in their clinic or laboratory on the same day," said Dr Mathur.

The health department will conduct monitoring of dengue cases and its surveillance closely. From daily reporting from doctors and laboratories, if it is found that increased number of dengue cases are reported from a particular area, immediate action will be taken to prevent its spread further.

Besides, the health department will take the support of community. It has launched a month-long campaign against seasonal diseases under which health department will conduct activities such as larvae demonstrations and anti-larval activities.

Stinging report:

So far, 1,844 cases of dengue have been reported in Rajasthan

Out of 1,844 cases, 782 were reported from Jaipur

Lowest number of dengue cases (22 in state and 11 in Jaipur) was reported in 31st week (last week) of the year

Highest number of cases (128 in state, 90 in Jaipur) was reported in second week of the year.
