Hundreds of people fell ill after consuming contaminated food at a 'shradh bhoj' at Badara village under the Noorsarai block in Nalanda district on Saturday night. One of the critically ill villagers was admitted to Noorsarai primary health centre on Sunday.

One Shailesh Kumar of the village said the villagers had consumed food at the house of Munnaji, whose father Jai Prakash Singh, a retired school inspector, had died recently. On Sunday morning, hundreds of villagers complained of shivering, loose motion, stomach ache and fever. Nalanda civil surgeon Dr Umeshwar Prasad Verma said a team of doctors was sent to the village from Noorsarai PHC with all required medicines after the matter came to light on Sunday.

However, incharge of Noorsarai PHC Dr I N Chaudhry, who was camping at the village along with Dr Mahesh Kumar and nursing staff, said at least 100 villagers, including women and children, were taken ill after consuming contaminated food. He said one Deepak Kumar was admitted to the Noorsarai PHC, while others responded to treatment at the village. The locals, however, put the number of affected villagers at 300.
