A group of 26 girl students from Andhra Pradesh, who had come to city to take part in SAE-BAJA, an off-road racing event organised at Pithampur every year, were admitted to MY Hospital early on Wednesday morning after they fell ill owing to suspected food poisoning.

A team of 57 people including 51 girl students of mechanical engineering and electrical & electronics engineering branch of Vishnu Engineering College from Bhimavaram district in AP had arrived on Monday and stayed at Hotel Dilip at Sarwate bus stand.

According to the project coordinator CH Sagar, the entire team had been consuming meals at Gurukripa Avenue restaurant for the past two days. "Almost everybody had consumed curd during dinner on Tuesday. Around 4am, 26 students complained of severe stomach ache, vomiting and diarrhoea and were immediately rushed to MY Hospital," Sagar told TOI.

He mentioned that the students who fell ill had come to the state for the first time. The doctors said that the students were found suffering from dehydration, which is a symptom of food poisoning. After the treatment, they recuperated and thus, all of them were discharged from the hospital by evening.

"The students had to give a presentation about the vehicle, they have developed. Since most of the students are not well, we now fear of failing to present our project in a proper manner," said Sagar.

"We have tied up with OYO rooms and the students coming from different states book these hotels. The incident is really sad and we will help out the students by offering them slots in the last session or on Thursday," SAE-BAJA organising committee member KC Vora told TOI.

Vora also asked the team members to check the condition of the students and provide help in whatever way possible.
