<b>Title:</b>	<b>8 children eat poisonous plant, taken ill in district Rewari, Haryana</b>

Eight children below the age of eight fell unconscious after eating some poisonous plant at Lilohad village in Rewari district on Sunday.

The children of brick-kiln labourers were admitted to the Civil Hospital, Jhajjar, from where they were discharged on Monday.

According to reports, the children, identified as Vikas, Raj, Anshu, Aakash, Manish, Naresh, Dalip and Kalu, were playing near a brick-kiln in the evening when they consumed a poisonous plant. They were earlier taken to a health centre at Jamalpur village, from where they were referred to the Civil Hospital as their condition was not stable.

"The children were brought here in a critical condition. But now all of them are stable and have been discharged. The plant they consumed was poisonous," said a doctor at the Civil Hospital.
