Some 46 students of a residential school in Chhota Udepur were admitted to the general hospital in Chhota Udepur town after they complained of fever and diarrhoea.

The residential school which is run by Pragat Purshottam Kelvani Mandal at Baroj village has 150 students. On Monday, the students had complained of cold, fever and diarrhoea following which the school principal called a medical team from public health centre at Malaja village. Even after administering medicines to 22 boys and 24 girls, their health did not improve on Tuesday.

The school authorities then admitted the students to the general hospital in Chhota Udepur town on Tuesday evening. Sources said that the students have been diagnosed of viral infection and were recovering well. "We provided primary treatment to the students with the help of primary health centre's team. But as their health did not improve we shifted the ailing students through 108 ambulance," said school's principal Raman Rathwa.
