Twenty students of a private school in Badaun were taken ill after consuming chowmein in the school canteen on Friday, prompting district magistrate, Anita Srivastava, to order an inquiry.

The students started vomiting and complaining of stomach ache, following which they were admitted to a private hospital for treatment.

Suspecting food poisoning to be the reason behind their condition, parents of the students wrote to the district administration complaining about the quality of food in the school canteen. The district magistrate immediately ordered an inquiry and samples of chowmein have been seized.

Meanwhile, the parents of the students also staged a protest outside the school. Srivastava said, "City magistrate, district inspector of schools and district food officer inspected the site. They recorded the statements of students and their parents. The samples have been seized for further tests."

"The condition of all students is stable and strict action will be taken against the guilty," she added.
