Title:	Second swine flu death in Dehradun, fourth in state

A 36-year-old man from Miyanwala in Dehradun succumbed to swine flu on Wednesday in a private hospital in the city.

Earlier, a 26-year-old school teacher from Chamoli, a 43-year-old woman from Dehradun and Tharali MLA, Magan Lal Shah, had died due to the seasonal influenza. Till now, 28 suspected blood samples have been sent to the central laboratory for testing of which 21 are negative while result of six samples are awaited and three people have died (excluding latest case). According to chief medical officer of Dehradun, Dr YS Thapliyal, "Miyanwala area has come under the health department scanner and the entire area is being sanitized while the family members of the deceased patient are being given anti-swinflu medicines as precautionary measure.", According to officials of Integrated Disease Surveillance Programme (IDSP) there is no fear from swine flu for healthy and fit people because it is now categorized under seasonal influenza, indicating a normal flu.

However, it can take a toll on people having low immunity and those who are suffering from other ailments, especially related to lungs, officials said.
