Six students of a government school were hospitalized, and their schoolmates' given first aid as they fell ill after consuming chocolates dumped at the roadside near Cuddalore in Tamil Nadu on Thursday, police said.

Sources said that a carton box containing hundreds of chocolates past their shelf life was dumped by the roadside, apparently by some dealers, near Koothkaudi which the students picked up and shared with their friends. Many of them complained of nausea after consuming chocolates. Six students - five girls and a boy, who fell seriously ill were admitted to the Koothakudi government hospital.

A medical team has landed at the school to give first aid to other students of the school. Veppur police are investigating the incident.
