Gastroenteritis (GE) and diarrhoea have started to spread its wings in Manpur village of Bokaro. Diarrhoea has claimed two lives while twelve villagers are coming in its grip with severe water crisis. Rajiv Thakur (22) and Pinki Kumar (3) died due to diarrhoea, said the villagers.

Villagers with the complaint of vomiting and having loose motion were admitted in Government hospitals and private nursing homes at Chandankiyari and Chas. Grippled with diarrhoea Kajal (85), Anand Thakur (35), Pushpa Devi (32), Rinku Lumari (15), Balram Thakur (61), Priya (16), Puspa (40), Sonu (7), gopal Dhami (65), Akash (9) including others are admitted to the hospital and administering 'saline', informed Anand a villager.

"Due to the shortage of drinking water in several villages, people are forced to drink contaminated water from ponds without boiling, which creates the bigger problem", said health officials. District health department officials suggested the villagers to be extra vigilant while taking any food including water.
