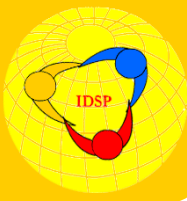

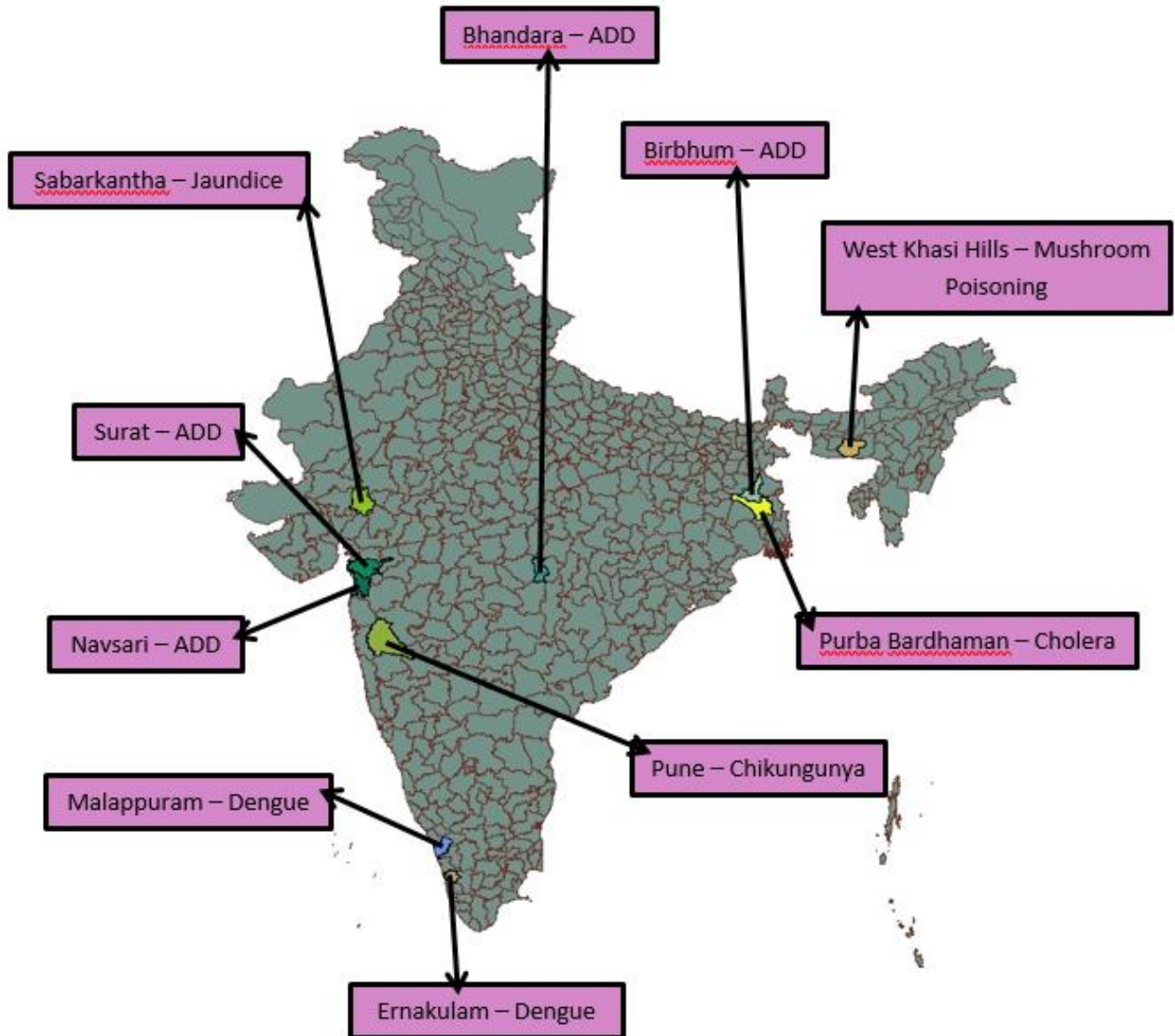

22nd Week Map

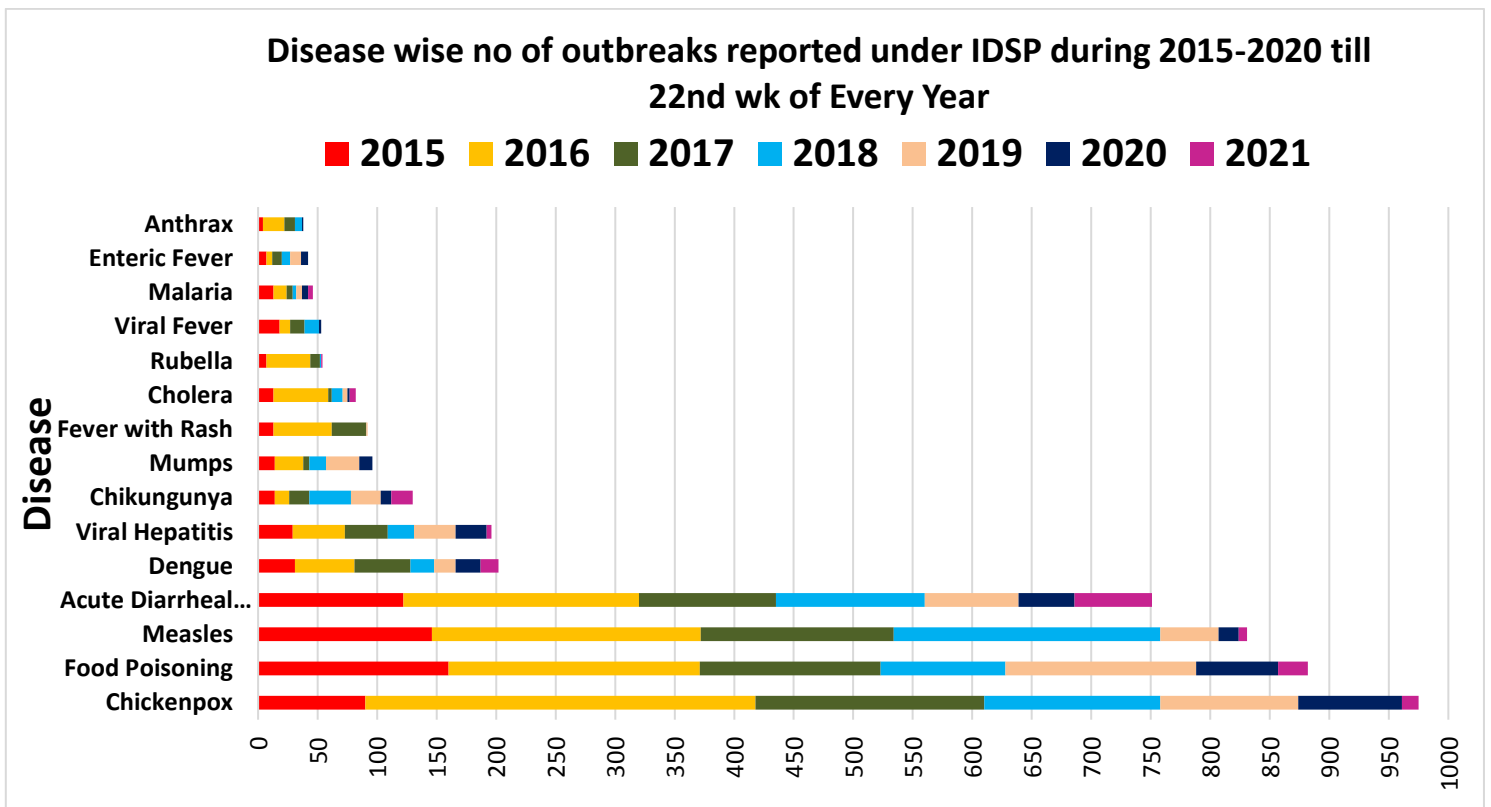
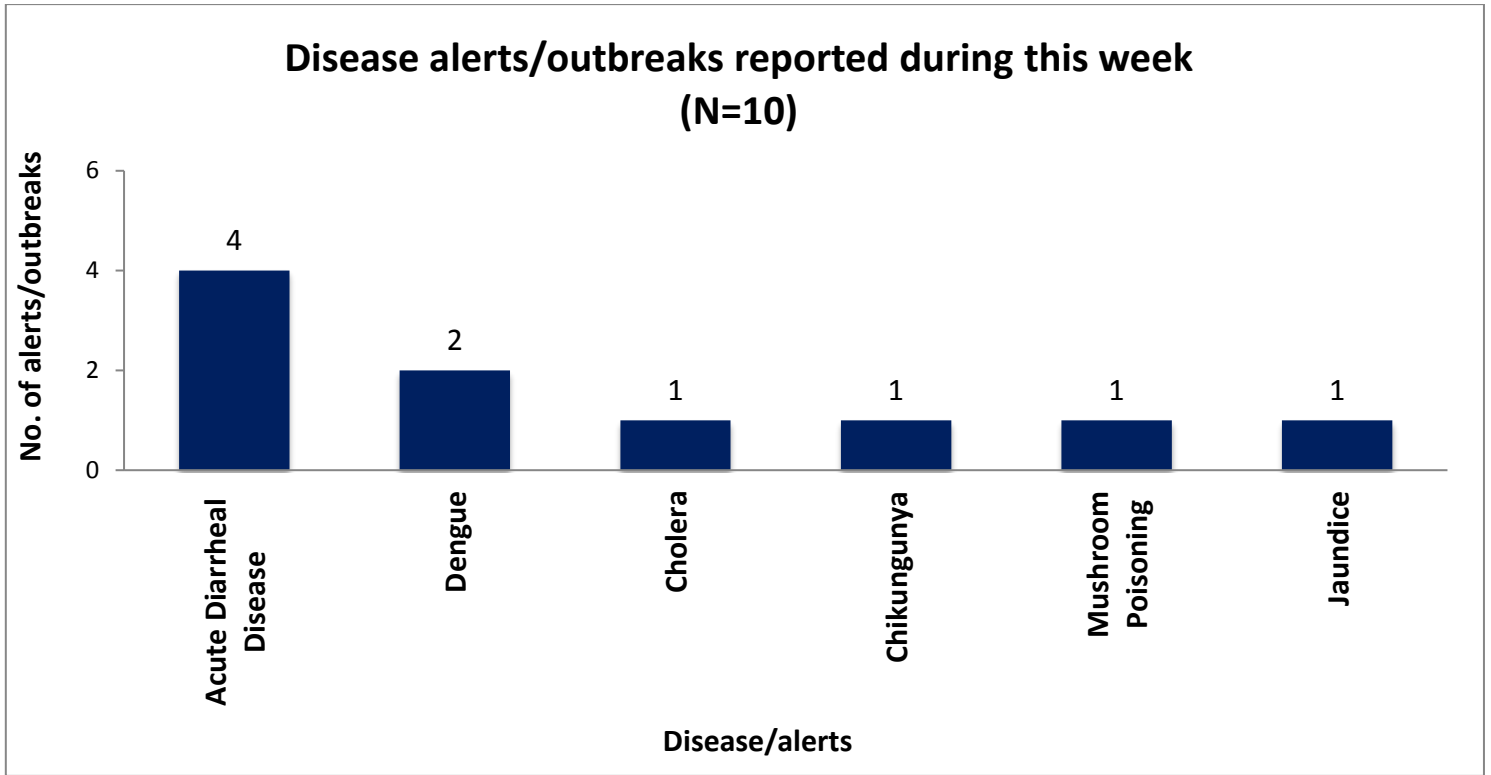

Out of 57 water samples, 07 water samples were found unfit for drinking purpose. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health Education was given.

Patient presented with complaints of diarrhea, vomiting, nausea & abdominal pain. 9 water samples were sent for further lab analysis, out of which 5 samples are found to be unfit for drinking purpose. 1 TCL and 3 stool samples were sent to DPHL Bhandara, no pathogen was present in the samples. 07 food samples were sent for further lab analysis, bacteria causing food poisoning was present in the samples. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health Education was given.

Other cases presented with fever, myalgia, nausea and vomiting. 06 blood samples were sent to RPH Lab in Ernakulam and they tested positive for IgM antibody. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health Education was given.

Malapuram, the result is awaited. NS1 Ag. IgM card test was found positive for all 20 cases. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health Education was given.
