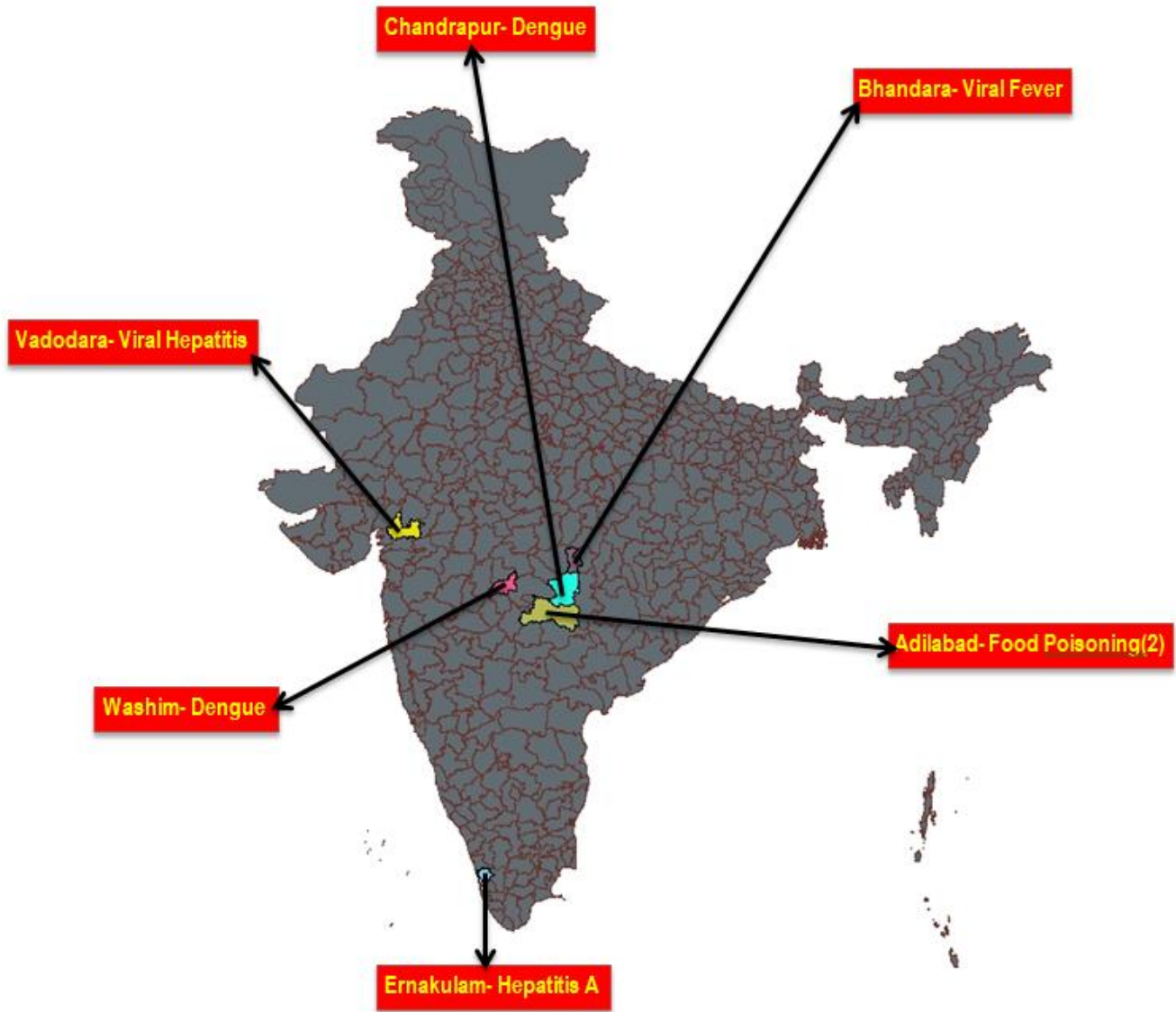

22nd Week Map

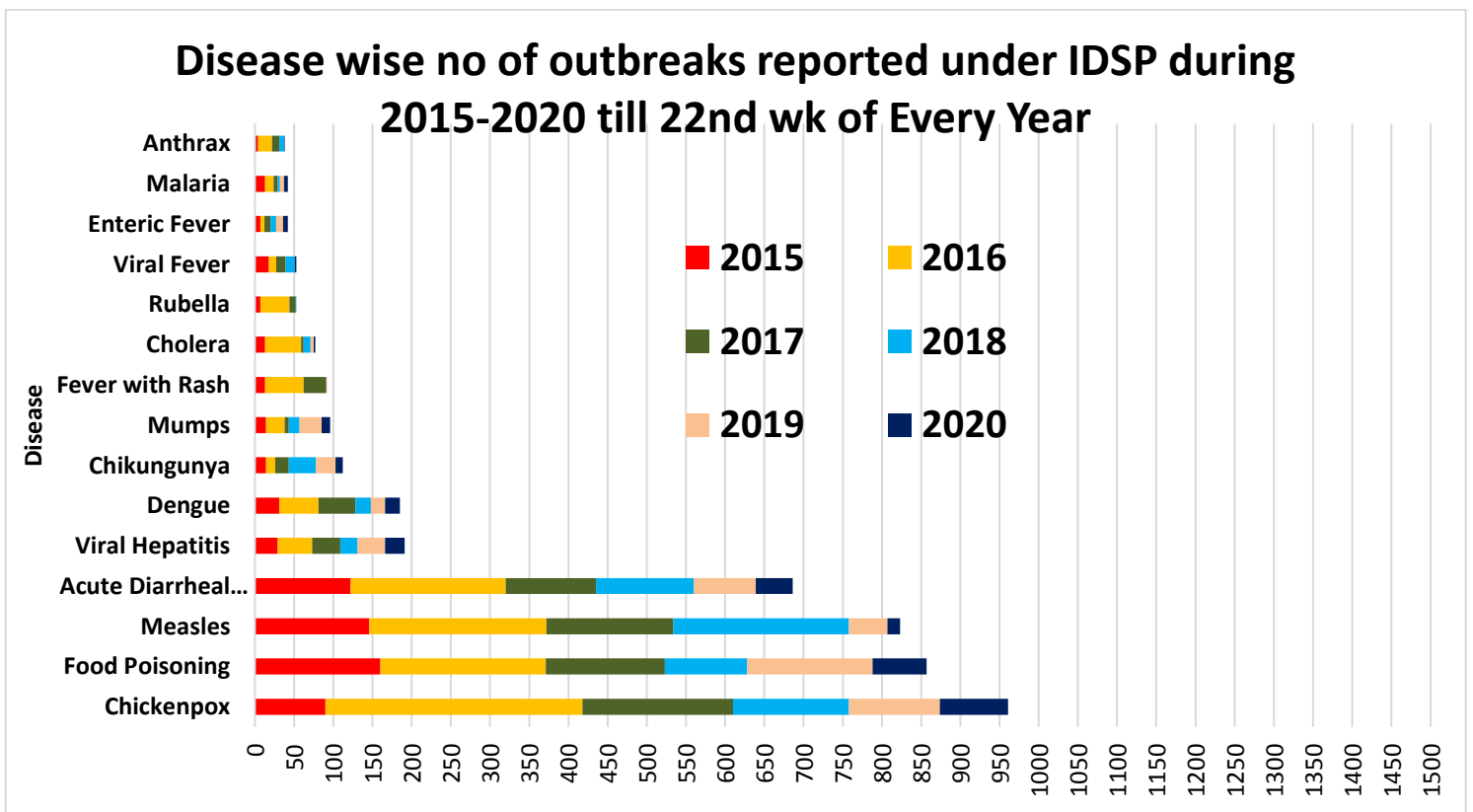
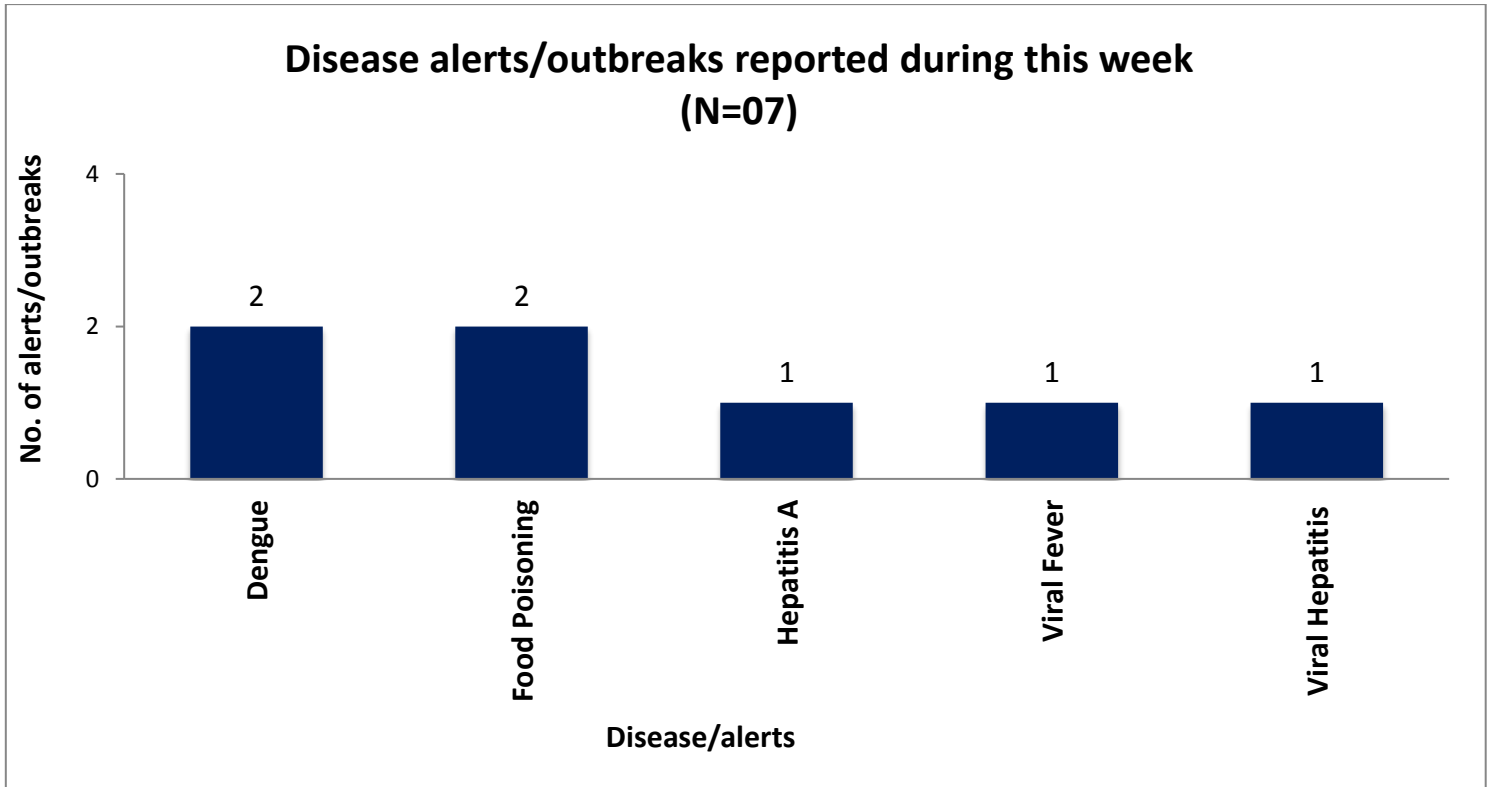
